

**ORDINANCE NO. 16-02**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TEXAS CITY, TEXAS, AMENDING CITY CODE 130.10 - REGULATION OF SEX OFFENDER RESIDENCY; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR THE READING OF THIS ORDINANCE ON THREE (3) SEPARATE DAYS; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND ADOPTION AND PUBLICATION BY CAPTION ONLY IN THE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER OF THE CITY.**

**WHEREAS**, upon recommendation of the Police Chief, and full review and consideration of all matters related and attendant thereto, the City Commission is of the opinion that the changes to the Sex Offender Code 130.10 – Regulation of Sex Offender Residency should be adopted for the Code for the City of Texas City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TEXAS CITY, TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION 1:** The Commission of the City of Texas City hereby approves amending of the City of Texas City Code 130.10 - Regulation of Sex Offender Residency as attached hereto as “**Exhibit A**” and made hereof for all intents and purposes.

**SECTION 2:** That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed. In the event any section, clause, sentence, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance shall be for any reason adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect, invalidate, or impair the remainder of this Ordinance.


**SECTION 3:** That this Ordinance shall be read on three (3) separate days and shall become effective upon its final reading, passage, and adoption.
