

RESOLUTION NO. 17- 061

A RESOLUTION APPROVING CONTRACT FOR DISASTER GENERATED DEBRIS REMOVAL, MANAGEMENT AND RELATED SERVICES WITH DRC EMERGENCY SERVICES; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND ADOPTION.

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide necessary and expedited removal of debris following Hurricane Harvey within the City of Texas City; and

WHEREAS, the City has taken competitive proposals and recommends the award of a contract for the most advantageous proposal to the offeror as per RFP# 2017-034, Disaster Debris Removal, Management and Related Services; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Management Coordinator recommends the City awards the contract to DRC Emergency Services and authorizes the execution of the necessary documents to procure said services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TEXAS CITY, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City of Texas City awards a proposal and authorizes the Mayor to execute a contract with DRC Emergency Services for removal of disaster generated debris, management and related services in accordance with Schedule I and II - Unit Rate Price of the proposal as set forth in Exhibit A.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
