

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-050

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING KATY-MARIE LYLES AS A MUNICIPAL JUDGE AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND ADOPTION.

WHEREAS, *Article X, Section 2*, of the **City Charter** requires that a Municipal Court shall be presided over by a judge who shall be known as the Municipal Judge; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Judges shall be appointed by a majority vote of the City Commission of the City of Texas City, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Court of Record is requesting the appointment of an additional judge to ensure proper coverage of court and jail dockets; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems it in the best interest of the City of Texas City to appoint, Katy-Marie Lyles as a Municipal Judge, for two-year terms, ending October 21, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TEXAS CITY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the City Commission of the City of Texas City, Texas, hereby appoints Katy-Marie Lyles as a Municipal Judges, to preside over the Municipal Court, for a two-year term, ending October 21, 2024.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption.
