A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PROFESSIONAL SERVICE PROVIDER(S) SELECTION FOR TEXAS CDBG-MIT REGIONAL MITIGATION PROGRAM'S METHOD OF DISTRIBUTION DEVELOPMENT (CDBG MIT-MOD) PROGRAM(S) FUNDED AND ADMINISTERED THROUGH THE TEXAS GENERAL LAND OFFICE (GLO).; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND ADOPTION.; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND ADOPTION.

WHEREAS, participation in CDBG MIT-MOD program(s) requires implementation by professionals experienced in the administration of federally-funded projects; and

WHEREAS, in order to identify qualified and responsive providers for these services a Request for Proposals (RFP) process for administration services has been completed in accordance with the GLO requirements; and

WHEREAS, the proposals received by the due date have been reviewed to determine the most qualified and responsive providers for each professional service giving consideration to ability to perform successfully under the terms and conditions of the proposed procurement, integrity, compliance with public policy, record of past performance, and financial and technical resources.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TEXAS CITY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the City Commission of the City of Texas City, Texas, hereby awards GRANTWORKS, INC. to provide application and project-related Administration Services for CDBG MIT-MOD program(s).

SECTION 2: That any and all project-related services contracts or commitments made with the above-named service provider(s) are dependent on the successful negotiation of a contract with the service provider(s).

SECTION 3: That the Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with GRANTWORKS, INC. for the respective unit prices bid in **Exhibit "A"** attached hereto and made a part hereof for all intents and purposes.

SECTION 4: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption.
