

RESOLUTION NO. 19-021

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE FEMA APPROVED TEXAS CITY, TEXAS, SINGLE JURISDICTION MULTI- HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND ADOPTION.

WHEREAS, the City of Texas City, Texas recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Texas City, Texas has created a city-wide Hazard Mitigation Plan for itself which is in accordance with the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, the City of Texas City, Texas Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the plan from impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, adoption by the City Commission demonstrates our commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Plan; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of this plan will make the City of Texas City eligible to apply for current open and future Hazard Mitigation Grants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TEXAS CITY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the City Commission hereby adopts the FEMA approved Texas City, Texas Multi-Hazard Mitigation

SECTION 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption.
