

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-167

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PAYMENT TO SIRSIDYNIX FOR THE MIGRATION TO A COMPANY-HOSTED SERVER FOR MOORE MEMORIAL PUBLIC LIBRARY'S INTEGRATED LIBRARY SYSTEM; PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND ADOPTION.

WHEREAS, SirsiDynix is the provider of Moore Memorial Public Library's Integrated Library System;

WHEREAS, the Moore Memorial Library is under a 5-year contract for this service. This software is used to manage all aspects of circulation, cataloging, the online catalogue, reports, and other library-specific needs; and

WHEREAS, the annual invoice for \$43,935.93 was paid in October 2024, but there is an additional one-time expense this year. At the recommendation of the IT Department, the library recently migrated our SirsiDynix computer server to one that is hosted by the company and not in-house. The payment for this migration of \$9,993.98 is now due.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TEXAS CITY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the City Commission hereby approves a one-time payment of \$9,993.98 to SirsiDynix.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption.
