The Corporation shall have all of the powers granted to non-profit corporations under the Act and other applicable law, including (without limitation) the power to incur financial obligations. These obligations shall not constitute a liability of the City. (The above purpose statements are taken from the Articles of Incorporation approved on 11/3/92.)
