WHEREAS, 409 Day is a time for each of us to reflect on and share what we love most about Texas City — the place we live, work, raise our families, go to school, and build our futures.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Mayor of the City of Texas City, and on behalf of the City Commission, do hereby proclaim April 9th as,
