PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Congress and President of the United States have designated May 15th as Peace Officers Memorial Day, and the week in which it falls as National Police Week; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement officers across the nation, including the dedicated members of the Texas City Police Department, serve with valor and integrity, safeguarding our communities and upholding the rule of law; and

WHEREAS, since the first recorded death in 1791, more than 24,000 law enforcement officers in the United States have made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty, their names forever etched on the National Law Enforcement Officers Memorial in Washington, D.C.; and

WHEREAS, National Police Week serves as a time to honor these fallen heroes, recognize the service of current officers, and express our gratitude for their unwavering commitment to public safety; and

WHEREAS, the City of Texas City acknowledges the selfless dedication of our local law enforcement officers, who risk their lives daily to protect our residents and uphold justice; an

Now, therefore, I, Mayor of the City of Texas City, and on behalf of the City Commission, do hereby proclaim the week of May 11–17, 2025, as

NATIONAL POLICE WEEK

and all citizens are encouraged to honor and support our law enforcement officers, past and present, and to remember those who have made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty.
