

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-121

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TEXAS CITY FIRE DEPARTMENT TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH WESTNET/FIRST-IN ALERTING TO INSTALL ALERTING SMART STATION SYSTEMS AT THE FIRE STATIONS; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND ADOPTION.

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Texas City Fire Department that the City Commission approve entering into a contract with Westnet/First-In Alerting for the installation of Smart Station Alerting Systems at all fire stations, replacing the obsolete Zetron alerting system to improve dispatch reliability; and

WHEREAS, approval of the HGAC Contract No. EC07-23 for the amount \$494,742.15 is available in the adopted FY 2025-2026 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TEXAS CITY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the City Commission of the City of Texas City, Texas, hereby approve entering into a contract with Westnet/First-In Alerting for the installation of Smart Station Alerting Systems via HGAC Contract No. EC07-23, as set out on the proposal attached hereto as **Exhibit “A”** and made a part hereof for all intents and purposes.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor is authorized to approve all change orders, up to 25% of the original contracted amount, without bringing the matter before the Commission.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption.
