

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-113

A RESOLUTION APPROVING REVISIONS TO THE CITY OF TEXAS CITY'S HISTORICAL PRESERVATION BYLAWS; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND ADOPTION.

WHEREAS, upon the inception of the Historical Preservation Committee in 2005, the Commission approved a 5-member board, consistent with other boards, commissions, and advisory bodies of the City. In 2006, the membership number changed to seven; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Staff to amend the Historical Preservation By-laws to their originally approved board count; and

WHEREAS, there is no fiscal impact for this item.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TEXAS CITY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: The City Commission hereby approves the revisions to the City of Texas City's Historical Preservation Committee By-Laws, as set out on **Exhibit "A"** attached hereto and made a part hereof for all intents and purposes.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption.
