

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-031

A RESOLUTION APPROVING ENTERING INTO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH GALVESTON COUNTY REGARDING 2025 COUNTY BOND PROJECTS TO PARTIALLY FUND IMPROVEMENTS TO CITY STREETS; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND ADOPTION.

WHEREAS, the Engineering Department is requesting to utilize the Interlocal Cooperation Act, as designed in Texas Gov't Code §§ 791.001 – 791.030, to partially fund improvements to the following city street projects:

1. Central Park Boulevard from FM 2004 to Century Boulevard
2. Monticello Drive from North Amburn Road to Memorial Drive
3. 9th Street bridge at 25th Avenue

WHEREAS, the County allocated \$8,500,000.00 in road funds to be used as the County's share for road improvements in the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TEXAS CITY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the City Commission hereby approves entering into an Interlocal Agreement with Galveston County regarding 2025 County Bond Projects to partially fund improvements to city streets.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an interlocal agreement with Galveston County for the price bid in **Exhibit “A”**, as attached hereto and incorporated herein for all intents and purposes.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption.
