

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-032

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT FOR ERP CONSULTING SERVICES; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND ADOPTION.

WHEREAS, the City received seven responses to RFQ 2026-014 for ERP Consulting Services. After a thorough evaluation, the review team selected BerryDunn as the most qualified firm; and

WHEREAS, the City's current ERP system is outdated, fragmented, and no longer meets operational needs. Core functions—including finance, purchasing, HR, payroll, utility billing, and asset management—operate on systems that lack integration, require manual workarounds, and limit reporting accuracy; and

WHEREAS, the City has ARPA funds available that may be used for this project. However, federal requirements mandate a competitive RFP process in order to utilize ARPA funding, and all ARPA funds must be obligated by December 31, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF TEXAS CITY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That the City Commission of the City of Texas City, Texas, hereby authorizes the execution of a contract for ERP consulting services for \$152,100.00.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to execute the documentation to enter into an agreement with BerryDunn.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and adoption.
