The following items were approved at the October 30, 2025 Broward MPO Board meeting:

2026 Broward MPO Board Meeting Dates

MPO staff will arrange, for the 2026 calendar year, the public notification of meetings and set due dates for materials to be included in MPO agenda items.

Agreement No. 26-04 Between Broward MPO and Cunningham Communications Consulting Company D.B.A. The Brand Advocates, Incorporated for Government Public Involvement Services in an Amount Not to Exceed \$5,000,000

Task Work Order (TWO) No. 1 to Agreement No. 26-04 for General Project Management Support in an Amount Not to Exceed \$40,060

TWO No. 2 for Communications and Content Creation in an Amount Not to Exceed \$99,575

TWO No. 3 for a Market Assessment in an Amount Not to Exceed \$124,125

TWO No. 4 for State of the Region in an Amount Not to Exceed \$25,425

MPO staff will work with The Brand Advocates to provide outreach support on a task-work-order basis. The Brand Advocates will provide general project management support, communications and content creation, facilitate a market assessment, and facilitate the MPO's State of the Region event.

MPO Regional Data and Transportation Analytics (MRDATA) TWO No. 4 Between Broward MPO and Deloitte Consulting LLP for SMART Grant Documentation Support & Development of SMART METRO Data and AI Stewardship Entity in an Amount Not to Exceed \$349,986.88

Deloitte Consulting will prepare and deliver all project materials, including datasets, software code, and documentation reports to ensure compliance with the United States Department of Transportation requirements and define the options to create and sustain a Data and AI Stewardship Entity.

Membership Appointments to the Transportation Disadvantaged Local Coordinating Board (LCB)

Membership appointments for the Florida Department of Transportation were made on the LCB.

Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Four Draft Tentative Work Program for Fiscal Year (FY) 2027 - 2031

The FDOT Work Program sets the funding for the planning, design, engineering, right-of-way acquisition, and construction of transportation improvement projects over the next five years.

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) Draft Tentative Five-Year Work Program for FY 2027 - 2031

The FTE Work Program sets the funding for the planning, design, engineering, right-of-way acquisition, and construction of Turnpike improvement projects over the next five years. Approval of this item included a Board-proposed amendment to widen the Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 from six to eight lanes between Atlantic Boulevard and the Broward/Palm Beach County Line on projects FM# 452077-1,-3, FM# 452078-1, and FM# 452114-1.

Projects FM# 4515762, 4549751, and 4439781 were amended in the TIP. Projects FM# 4549741 & 4515731 were removed from the TIP.
