

# SUMMARY

## March 12, 2026 MPO Board Meeting: Action & Non-Action Items

The following items were approved at the March 12, 2026 Broward MPO Board meeting:

### **Subrecipient Agreement for the Federal Railroad Administration's Railroad Crossing Elimination Grant for the Broward County Sealed Corridor Project**

Florida East Coast Railway L.L.C. (FECR) will take over as the Subrecipient under the Railroad Crossing Elimination Grant to address assignment of the Final Design Consultant to FECR, Partner Funding Agreement, and applicable Workers' Compensation requirements.

### **Fiscal Year 2025 Audit Report Prepared by HCT Certified Public Accountants & Consultants, LLC**

MPO staff will submit the audit report to the State of Florida Auditor General, the Federal Highway Administration, Federal Transit Administration and the Florida Department of Transportation.

### **Draft Fiscal Year 2027 - Fiscal Year 2028 Unified Planning Work Program for Submittal to Funding Agencies for Review**

MPO staff will submit the draft Unified Planning Work Program to funding agencies for review and receive feedback from Federal and State agencies as to the appropriateness of the transportation programs, projects, MPO staff activities and funding expenditures identified in the document. This item will come back for final approval at the May MPO Board meeting.

The March 12, 2026 Broward MPO Board meeting non-action items are summarized below:

### **Mobility Advancement Program MAP Broward**

Broward County staff was available to answer questions from the Board. This item will come back for a formal presentation at a future meeting.

### **Port Everglades Master/Vision Plan Update**

Port Everglades' staff presented the Master Vision Plan from 2026 to 2046. The presentation included guiding principles such as increasing capacity, enhancing efficiency and preserving the environment. Views of the planned projects in the 5-, 10-, and 20-year timeframes were shown.

### **Broward Safety Action Plan Policy Analysis**

MPO staff presented a hard copy of the Policy Analysis document to the Board Members present.

### **Broward County Transit - Transit Development Plan**

Broward County Transit staff provided a presentation of the 2026-35 Transit Development Plan which represents the vision for public transportation in Broward County over the next 10 years and functions as the strategic guide for public transportation in the County.
