May 14, 2026 MPO Board Meeting: Action Items

The following items were approved at the May 14, 2026 Broward MPO Board meeting:

Government Public Involvement Services Task Work Order (TWO) No. 5 Between the Broward MPO and The Brand Advocates for Infrastructure Week Including University Drive Event in an Amount Not to Exceed \$22,400

The Brand Advocates will assist MPO staff with planning, coordination, and execution of Infrastructure Week and the University Drive event.

TWO No. 6 Between the Broward MPO and Greater Fort Lauderdale Transportation Management Association (TMA) for Commute Broward Education and Advancement in an Amount Not to Exceed \$49,992.58

The TMA will continue to promote and implement transportation demand management strategies in Broward County through the Commute Broward program in partnership with the Broward MPO and Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT).

Amendments to the Fiscal Year 2026–2030 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP):

A. FM# 4515741 FLL/Hollywood Int'l Airport Taxilane ADG III Serving Westside Parcels

B. FM# 454279-1 BROWARD BLVD TRUCK PARKING EXPANSION BROWARD BLVD AT I-95

Project FM# 454279-1 was amended in the TIP. Project FM# 4515741 was removed from the TIP.

A. The MPO's Fiscal Year 2027 - Fiscal Year 2028 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) and Updated Travel Policy for Submittal to Funding Agencies for Approval

This was the MPO Board's final approval of its UPWP/budget. The approved UPWP now will be submitted to funding agencies for their respective final approval and will go into effect July 1, 2026.

B. Authorization for the MPO Chair, Executive Director, and/or General Counsel to Execute All Documents, Agreements and Amendments to Agreements as Necessary to Receive Funding for the Broward MPO's Approved FY 27 - 28 UPWP

This authorization will enable the MPO to react quickly and make changes to its Board-approved UPWP/budget or UPWP-related documents to ensure continuity of funding to the MPO. All changes are reported to the Board under the Financial Reports section of the agenda. This authorization does not extend to other agreements or documents unrelated to the UPWP.

C. Merit Increase Policy for MPO Staff for the Two Fiscal Years of the UPWP (July 1, 2026 to June 30, 2028) in Which a 4% Cost-of-Living Adjustment (COLA) and 3% Merit Increase May Be Applied to a Staff Member's Base Salary, and Allowing for Contributions to Be Made to a Staff Member's Deferred Compensation Plan

A 4% COLA and a maximum merit increase of 3% based on staff annual performance evaluations for each of the next two fiscal years, as well as contributions to staff member deferred compensation plans (as budgeted for in the UPWP), has been budgeted for MPO staff over the course of the approved FY 2027 – FY 2028 UPWP. After extensive discussion, the Board provided feedback on this item and requested robust background information prior to changes to the merit increase policy as part of future budgetary cycles.
