

FAIR HOUSING MONTH PROCLAMATION OF APRIL AS FAIR HOUSING MONTH

WHEREAS, Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, as amended, prohibits discrimination in housing and declares it a national policy to provide, within constitutional limits, for fair housing in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the principle of Fair Housing is not only national law and national policy, but a fundamental human concept and entitlement for all Americans; and

WHEREAS, the National Fair Housing Law, during the month of April, provides an opportunity for all Americans to recognize that complete success in the goal of equal housing opportunity can only be accomplished with the help and cooperation of all Americans; and

WHEREAS, Texas strengthened these protections with the passage of the Texas Fair Housing Act in 1989, prohibiting discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, familial status, or disability, to dismantle unjust barriers, expand opportunity, and uphold the dignity and worth of every Texan.

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, the ATASCOSA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT, do proclaim April as Fair Housing Month in Atascosa County, Texas, and do hereby urge all the citizens of this locality to observe the occasion with appropriate ceremonies and activities to support the Fair Housing law.
