

AMENDMENT NO. 3
TO
CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into on _____, 2016, by and between the following:

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the City and Contractor have entered into a contract dated July 13, 2009, for Contractor to provide engineering services to the City for Work Order 09-12 Inner Belt Loop, and;

WHEREAS, the City has need for additional engineering services, and;

WHEREAS, the City has authority to contract for consulting engineering services, and;

WHEREAS, the Contractor represents that he is qualified to perform such services, is in compliance with Montana Statutes relating to the registration of professional engineers and is willing to furnish such services to the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms, conditions, covenants and performance contained herein, or attached and incorporated herein, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

Part I, Section 3. Time for Performance, paragraph C. is amended as follows:

This Contract shall terminate at midnight on December 31, 2017.

Appendix A – Basic Services of Engineer, Section 3 Scope of Work is amended as follows:

Add the Paragraph above the heading which reads, “Payment for Basic Services” in Section 3 and add the following:

1. Alternative Route Evaluation Services

- Sanderson Stewart’s Project Manager and/or project staff shall attend planning and coordination meetings at the request of the City of Billings.
- Analyze selected alternative routes as requested by the City of Billings. Analysis to include layout of horizontal alignments and vertical grade to meet the design criteria selected by the City of Billings. Analysis shall also consider location and elevation of roadway with respect to the proximity of the Airport and FAA regulations.
- Provide field survey for surface topography and location of key features required for concept design at selected locations approved by the City of Billings.
- Provide plan and profile exhibits for each of the selected routes.
- Provide a roadway model and drive-through presentation for selected routes using Infracore visualization software at the request of the City of Billings.
- Provide Engineer’s Estimate of Probable Costs for alternatives selected by the City of Billings.

Appendix B – Methods and Times of Payment, Section 1.A.

Payment for the **Alternative Route Evaluation Services** identified in this amendment shall be made on a Time and Materials Basis with a not to exceed amount of **\$48,000**. If the City of Billings requests services beyond the not to exceed amount stated above, an increase in fee will be negotiated and the contract will be amended accordingly.

Payment for the tasks in the original contract (Appendix B) shall remain the same in the amount of \$782,800. Payment for the tasks identified in the Contract Amendment 1 shall remain the same in the amount of \$20,300. Payment for the tasks identified in the Contract Amendment 2 shall remain the same in the amount of \$62,000. The total contract amount including this amendment is **\$913,100.00**.

Appendix E – Project Schedule is amended as follows:

The work identified in this amendment shall be completed as follows:

Once Sanderson Stewart receives the City of Billings’s authorization to proceed, the work will begin within 7 calendar days. The City and Sanderson Stewart are aware that many factors outside Sanderson Stewart’s control may affect Sanderson Stewart’s ability to complete the services to be provided under this agreement. Sanderson Stewart will perform these services with reasonable diligence and expediency consistent with sound professional practices.

All other terms and conditions of the contract to which this amendment applies shall remain in full effect.
