Scott Walker thanked and commended the consultants for their work on this plan. The purpose of this project is to update the goals and objectives; consider existing conditions and identify needs; and move towards implementation. He pointed out the 5-page Executive Summary which includes a quick glance at the short-term project list. He reviewed the acknowledgment list and stated there were several great partnerships for this plan; and he thanked them for their involvement.
