Emergency Subsistence Payments	<p>Short-term emergency payments, up to six months, made on behalf of low-income individuals to prevent homelessness including rent, mortgage, and / or utilities. Assistance cannot be provided for non-consecutive months.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Beneficiaries must demonstrate financial unmet need including late payment, eviction, and / or shut-off communications for each month assistance is needed. Payments must be made directly to the landlord, lender, or utility company. Payments for water must exclude built-in costs for depreciation, operations, maintenance, and payments to external vendors. Payments in arrears must include up to six consecutive months. Payments cannot be made in advance for future months. If rent or mortgage assistance is provided beyond 100 days, the organization's staff must conduct and document a Visual Assessment for Lead-Based Paint. Training is free and available online. 		X
