

With respect to the aesthetic appeal of this type of fencing;

My 920 Howard home is in the alley between Howard and Cook, between 9th & 10th St. W. When I initially received the complaint notice from the Zoning Dept., I was under the impression that one of my neighbors complained about the patio enclosure even though it had been in place for over 5 years. So, I went to **every neighbor** on all 4 sides of the block (Howard, Cook, 9th St. W & 10th St. W) with the attached document to ask if any of my neighbors had ANY objection to the materials used or to the enclosure itself, and if they'd like they could add any comments that they would like to include for the Zoning Dept.

Even though I went back around the block on 2 separate days during the week and 1 time on Saturday.. there was 1 home at 214 9th St. W was never home so I don't have their signature/comment. (and 1 home at 913 Cook that's vacant)
