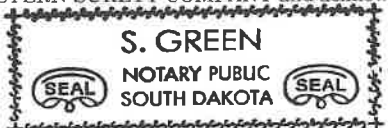

CLARIFICATIONS:

1. Work associated with Alternate #1 is anticipated to take place after October 15 following shut down of the BBWA canal. If the Alternate is accepted, 14 calendar days will be provided for completion of the alternate. Existing vault to remain intact until new supply line from canal ins installed. Route line from existing supply line to pump through wall of vault as required. Following installation of the new supply line from the canal, the existing vault shall be removed and the z-pipe and drain on the inlet side of the pump shall be adjusted to match the depth of the new supply line. The cost for these adjustments shall be included in the bid amount for Alternate #1. In the event that the canal is low enough during installation of the irrigation system to complete the boring work and the necessary forces are available, the work is expected to be completed.
