AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS,  
PROVIDING THAT SECTION 22-408 OF THE BILLINGS,  
MONTANA CITY CODE (BMCC) BE AMENDED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BILLINGS THAT:

**Section 1.** That Section 22-408 of the Billings, Montana City Code (BMCC) is amended to read as follows:

**Section 22-408. ~~Failure to remove obstructions.~~ Right-of-way Obstructions and Blocking Access to Entrances.**

~~(1) Any No~~ person ~~who shall willfully and unnecessarily~~ obstruct any sidewalk, street, or alley, ~~or without first obtaining permission of the city or who shall~~ fail to remove any obstruction placed in or upon any street, sidewalk, or alley. ~~Whenever any~~ permission previously granted ~~shall have~~ been withdrawn ~~by the city, or when notified to do so by the city,~~ the obstruction must be removed immediately.

~~(2) No person shall obstruct or hinder an entrance to a commercial building, interfere with ingress and egress, or otherwise occupy or impede the doorway to a commercial building.~~

Violations shall be subject to civil penalties as specified in section 18-1304.

**Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after second reading and final adoption as provided by law.

**Section 3. REPEALER.** All resolutions, ordinances, and sections of the City Code inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**Section 4. SEVERABILITY.** If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions of this ordinance which may be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and, to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.
