4. New Business: The board has been talking about getting a web site that has more information about the activity of the board. City Staff has been able to determine that a member of city staff can update the web site without a cost to the board. If the board were to hire someone to put a web site together it would have to be a web site the board pays fees for. If city staff adds to the existing web site there would not be a cost to the board for the additions to the existing city web site for the board. It was suggested that someone be hired to recommend what to put on the web site or the connections to be made from the YHPB web site to other sites.

Lauren suggested that instead of doing that just make hyper links to the things the board was directly involved in with other organizations. As an example, the projects that the WHC did as a consultant to the YHPB: examples, walking tours, cohagen homes in billings, etc.

Then you can do hyper links to the WHC for further historic information and things happening in Billings. You can also connect to the state web site for information of specific homes on the historic registry and district in Billings.
