New MCPs Project Eligibility

- **Roadway Improvements**

(Florida Statutes Section 212.055(1) and Second Amendment Section III.G)

- New Roadway or Bridge
- Widen Existing Roadway or Bridge
- Traffic Calming Projects

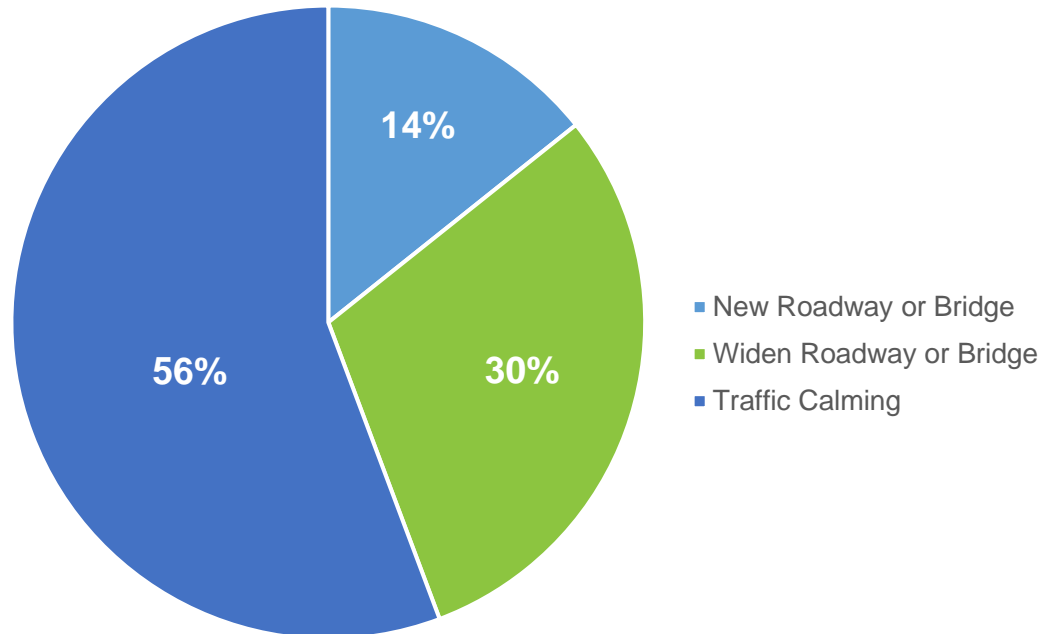

Important Dates to Remember

- **March 11th** - New MCPs 2022 application period opens for 28 days. Municipalities may submit completed applications.
- **April 8th** - New MCPs 2022 application period closes. The submittal period ends at 5:00PM EST.
- **June 1st** - A list of ranked New MCPs will be provided by the MPO to the MAP Administration (*Section IV.B.1 of the Second Amendment*).
