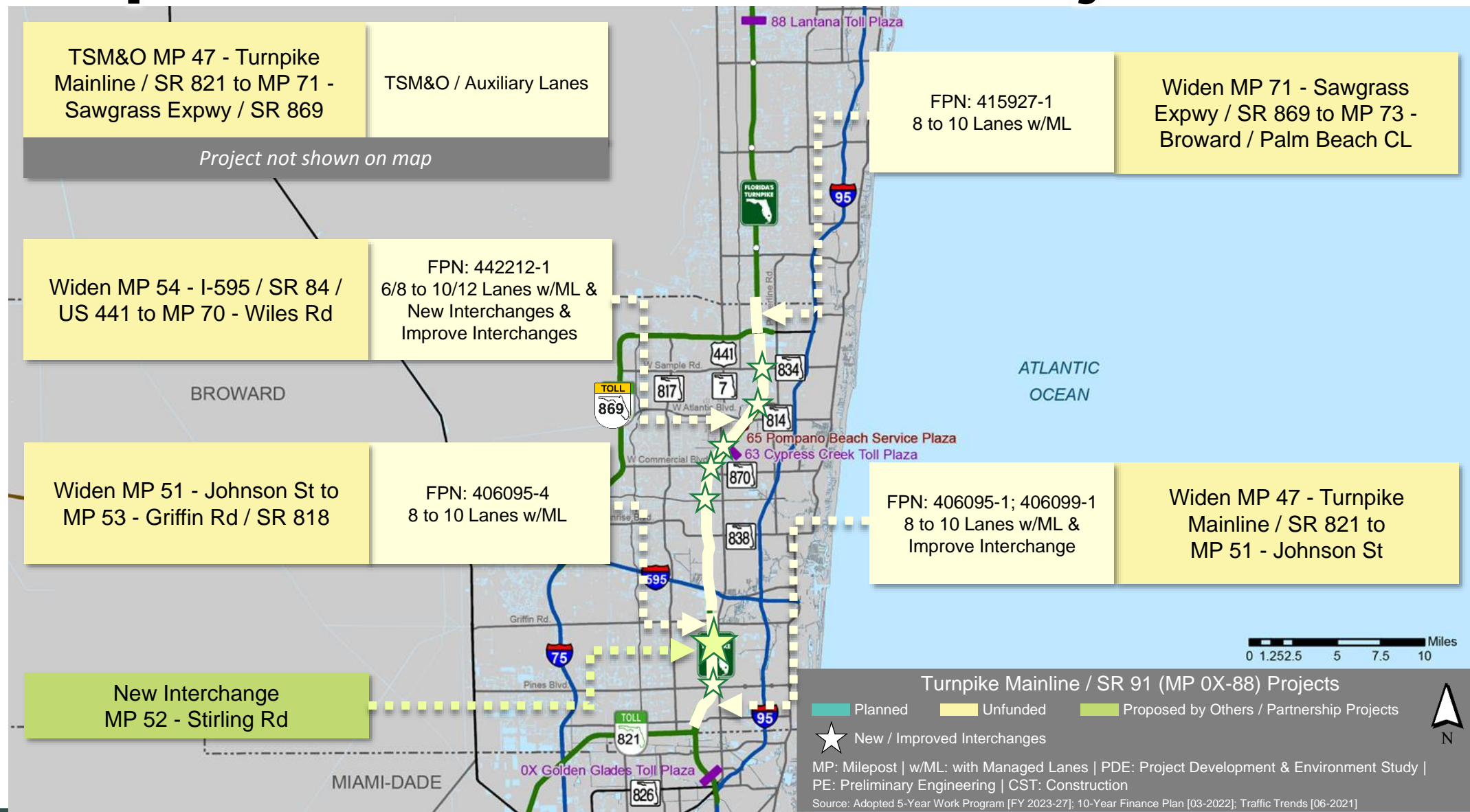

Turnpike Thru Lane Features

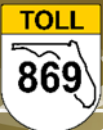
- Same toll amount for all lanes
- Separated from general lanes
- Limited points of entry and exit
- Serve longer trips
- SunPass only
- No trucks
- Buses allowed



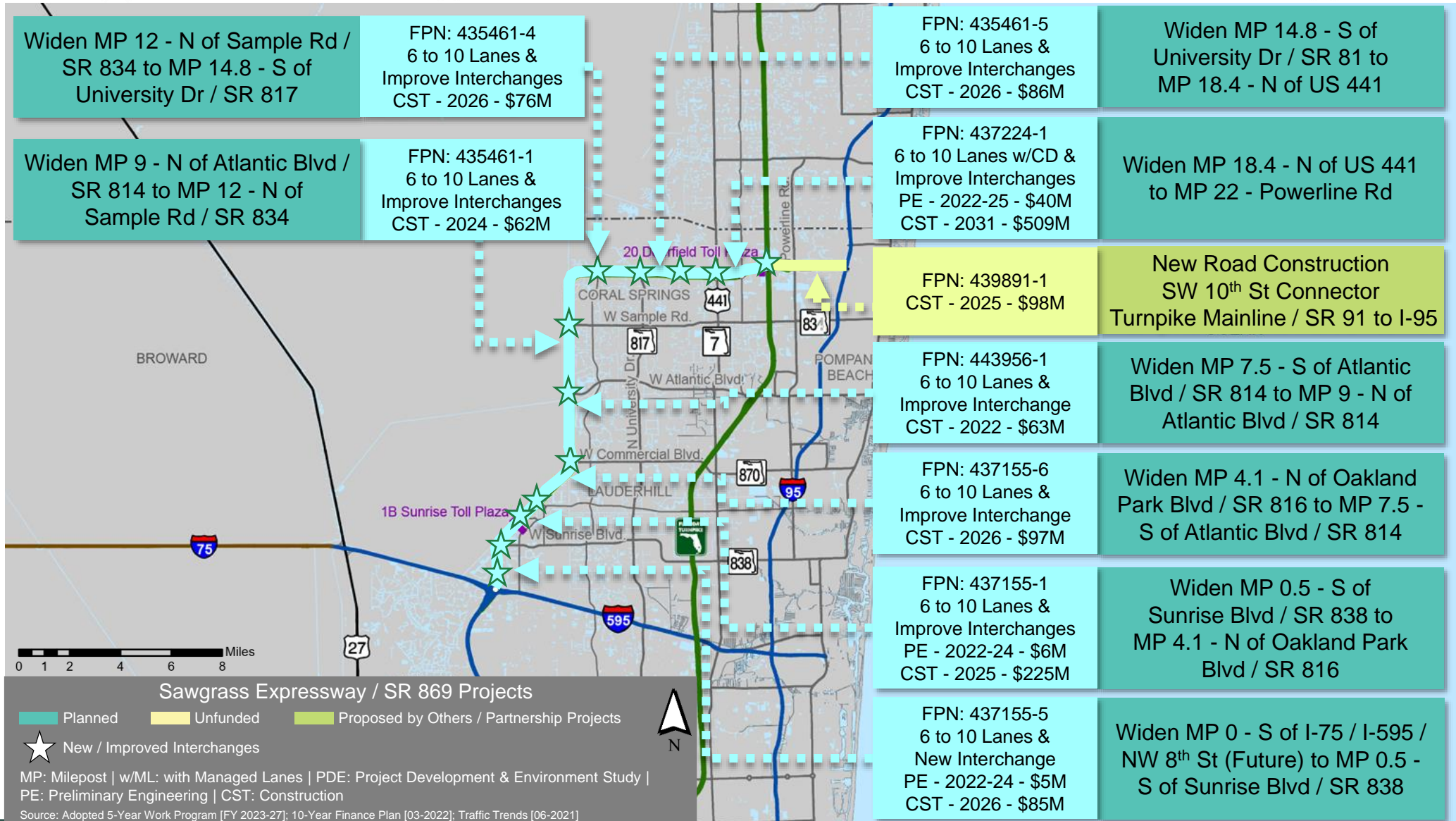
Turnpike Operational Strategies
