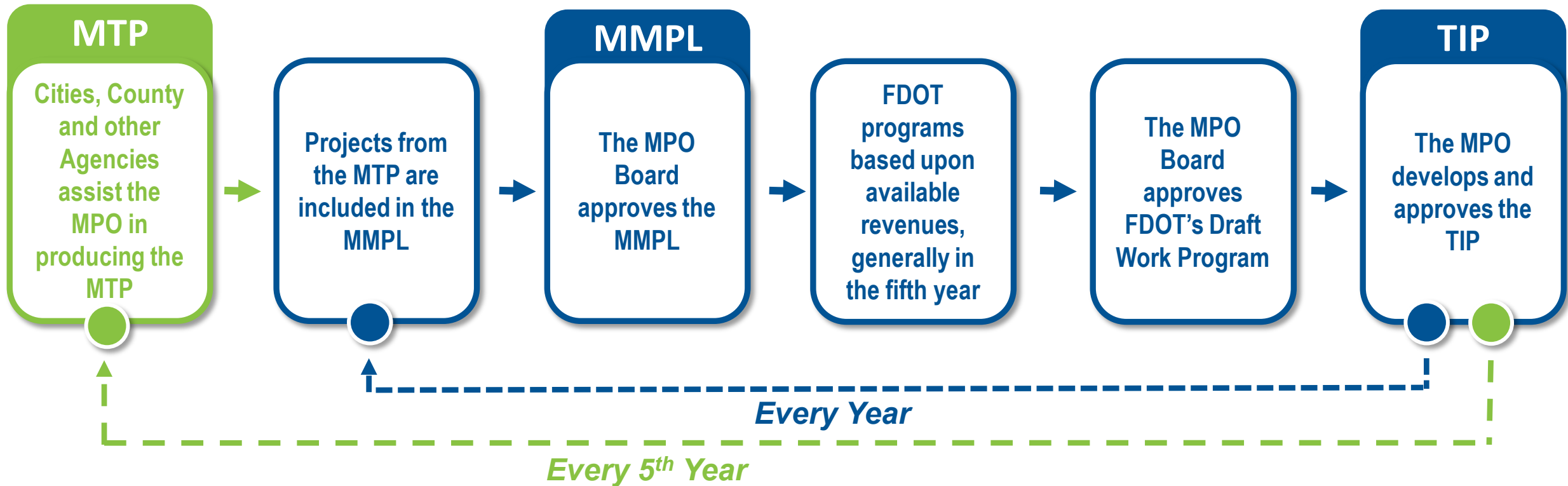
MPO VISION STATEMENT

⑨ Send Interim TIP to TIP distribution list (*July 1*)

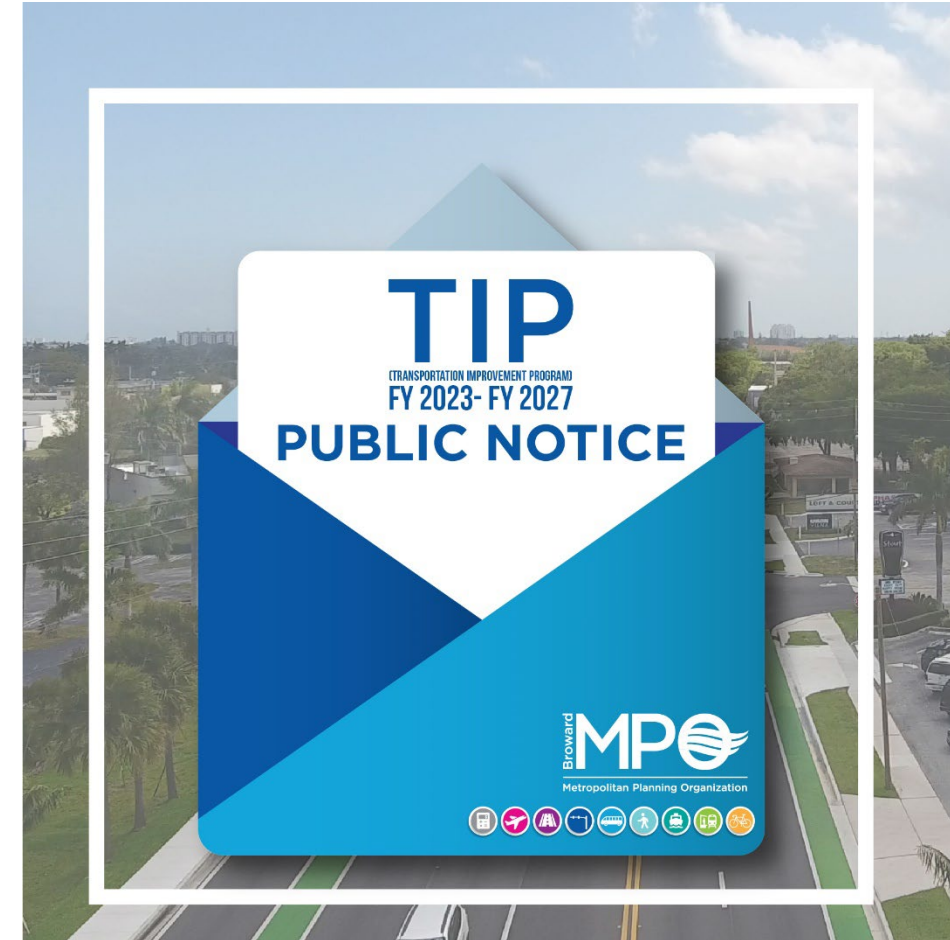
⑩ Board Approval

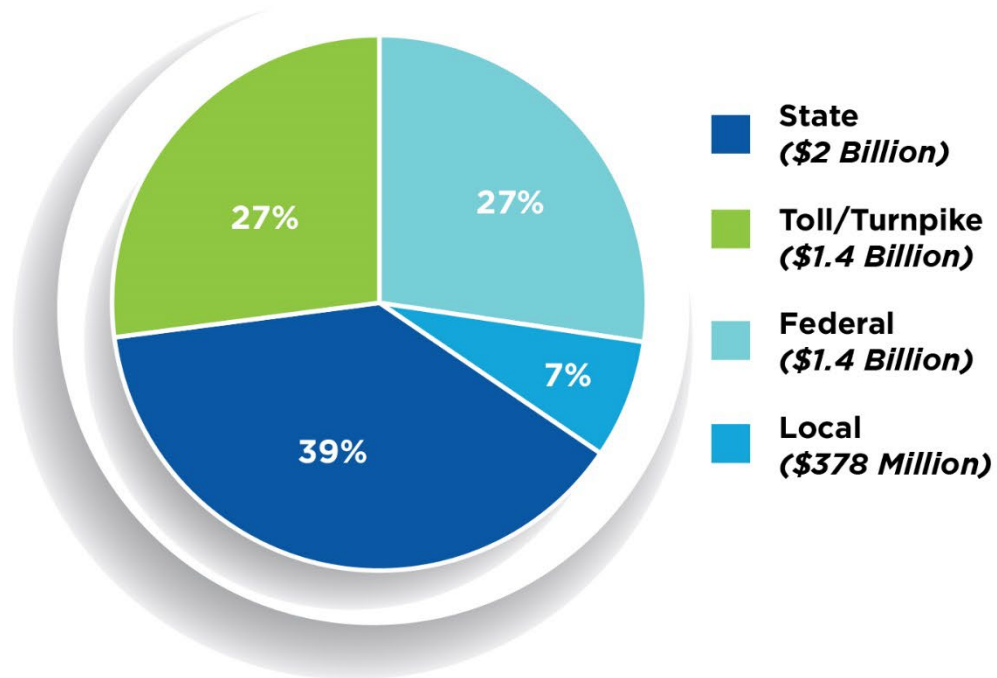

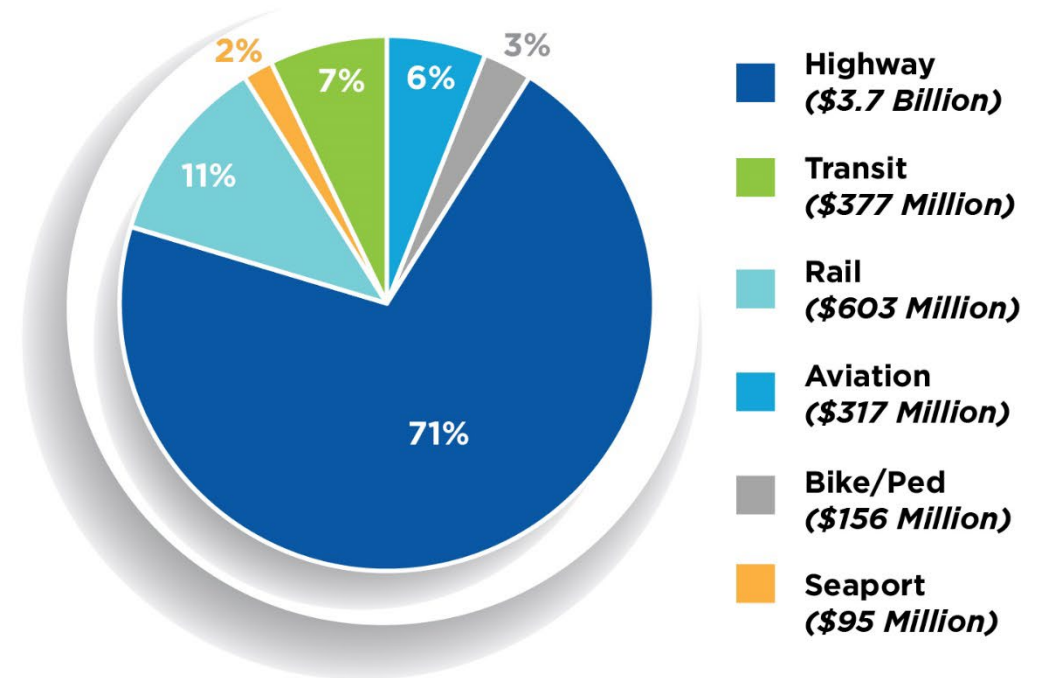

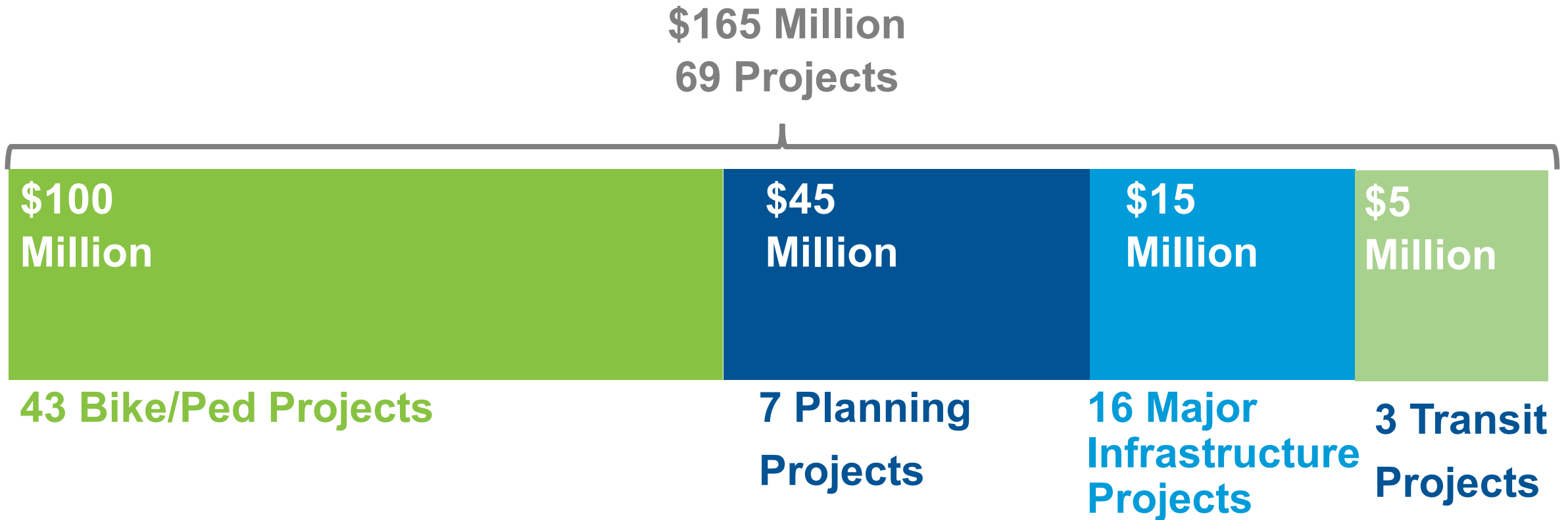
Funding Summary by Source
