Previously approved by TAC CAC MPO Board

Focused on:

- Market Readiness
- Sponsor Readiness

Mobility Hubs Program Funding Options

- Two funding options
 - Phase 1 Mobility Hub Master Plan
 - MPO will lead study in partnership with applicant
 - Project/application maximum for Mobility Hub Master Plans is \$400,000
 - Phase 2 Design & Construction
 - Applicant expected to lead or potential to use Metro Transportation Engineering & Construction Cooperative (M-TECC)
 - Project/application Minimum for Design and Construction is \$1 million
 - Both phases require FTA approval through TrAMS application process.
 - 3-6 months approval process
