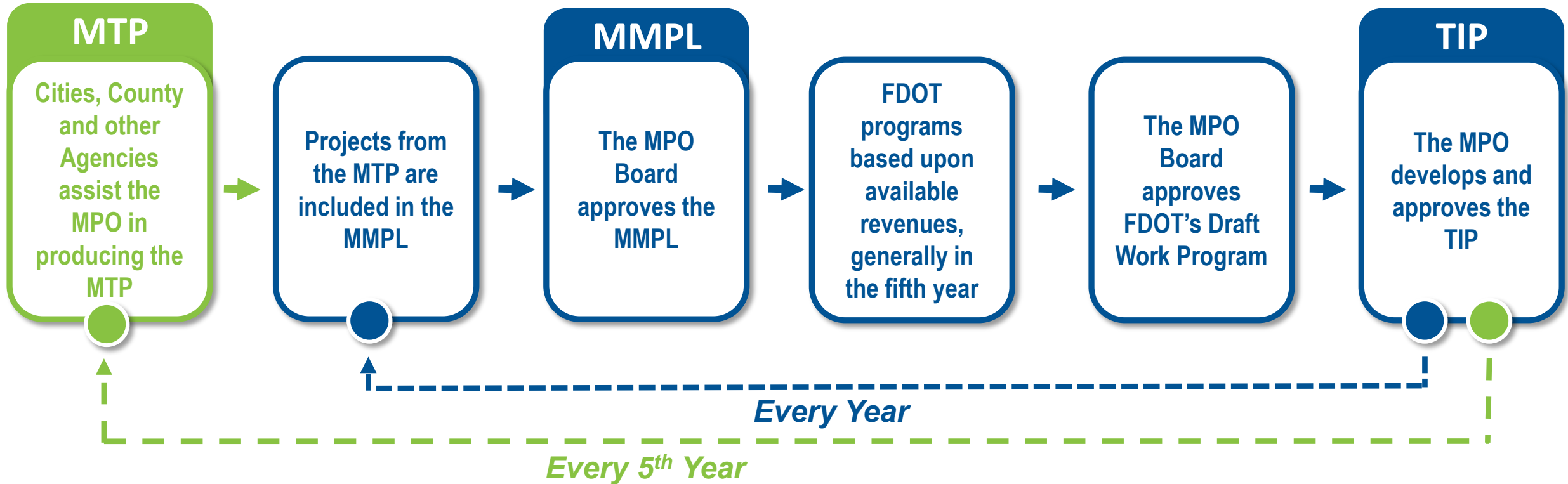

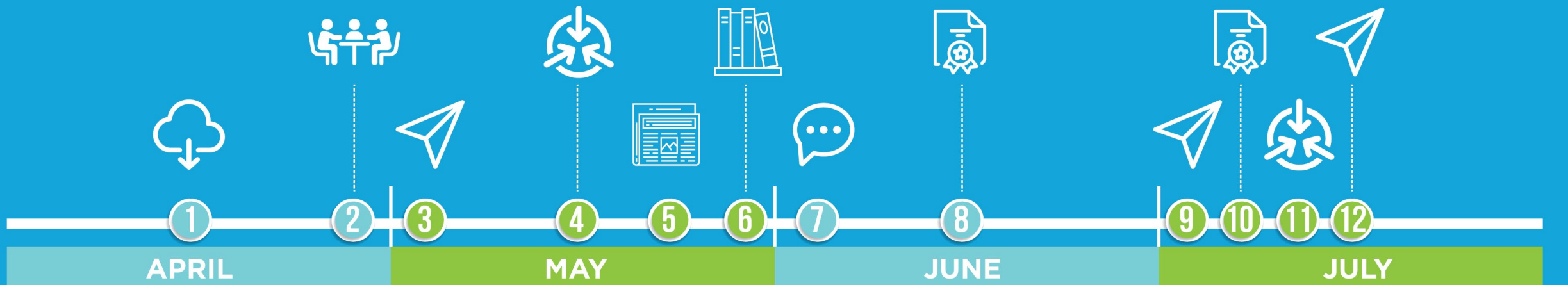

⑨ Send Interim TIP to TIP distribution list (July 1)

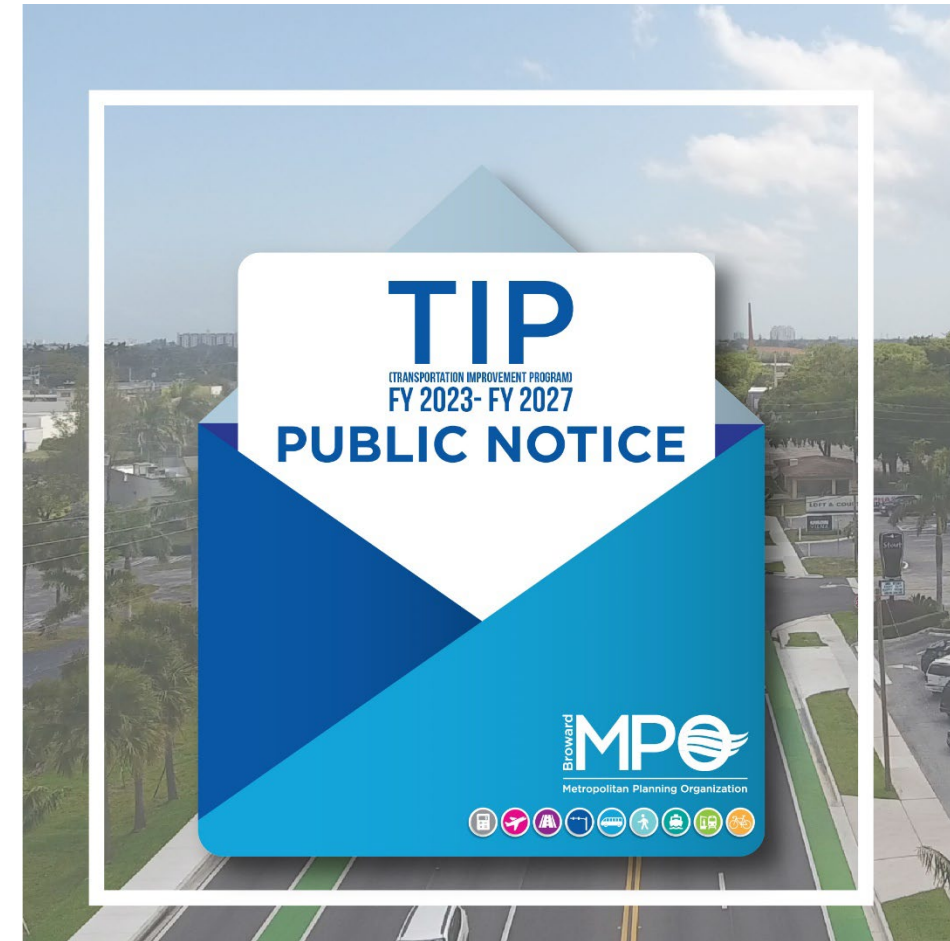
⑩ Board Approval

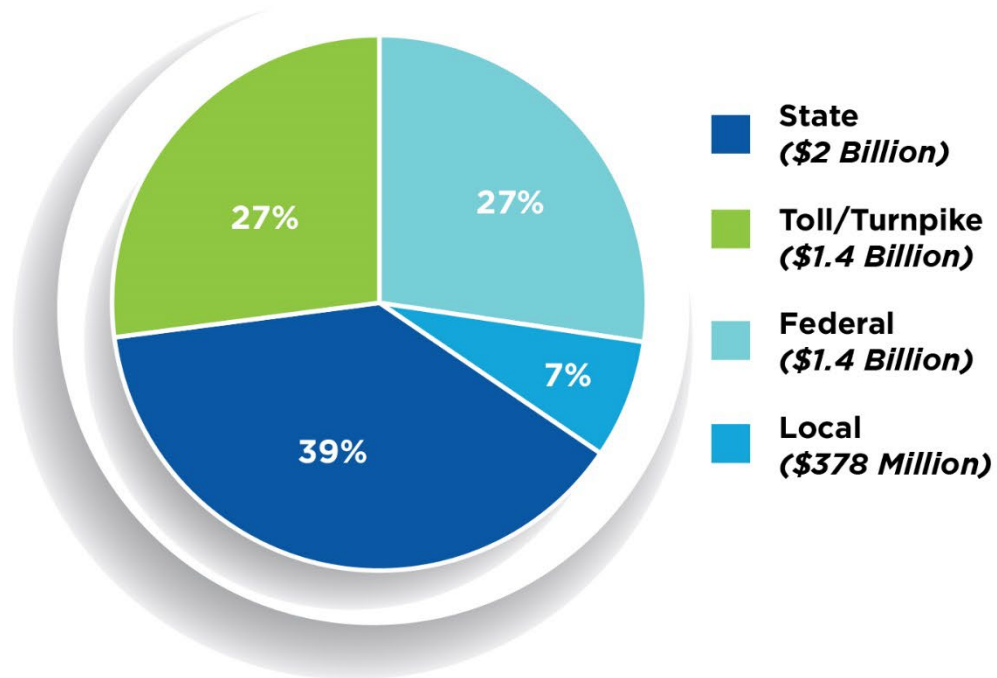

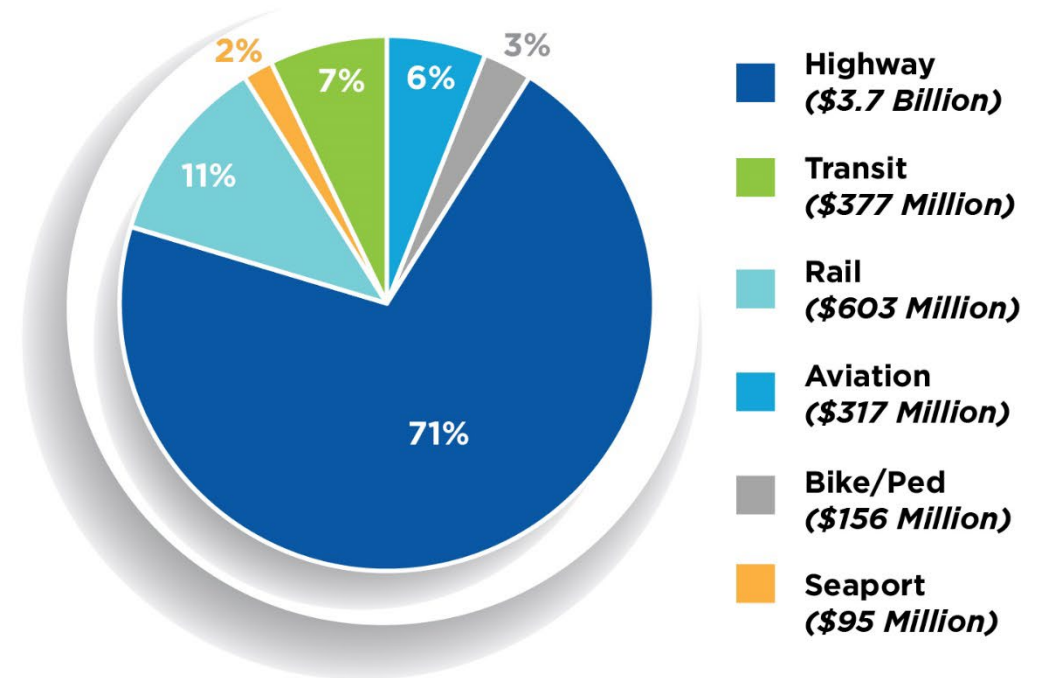

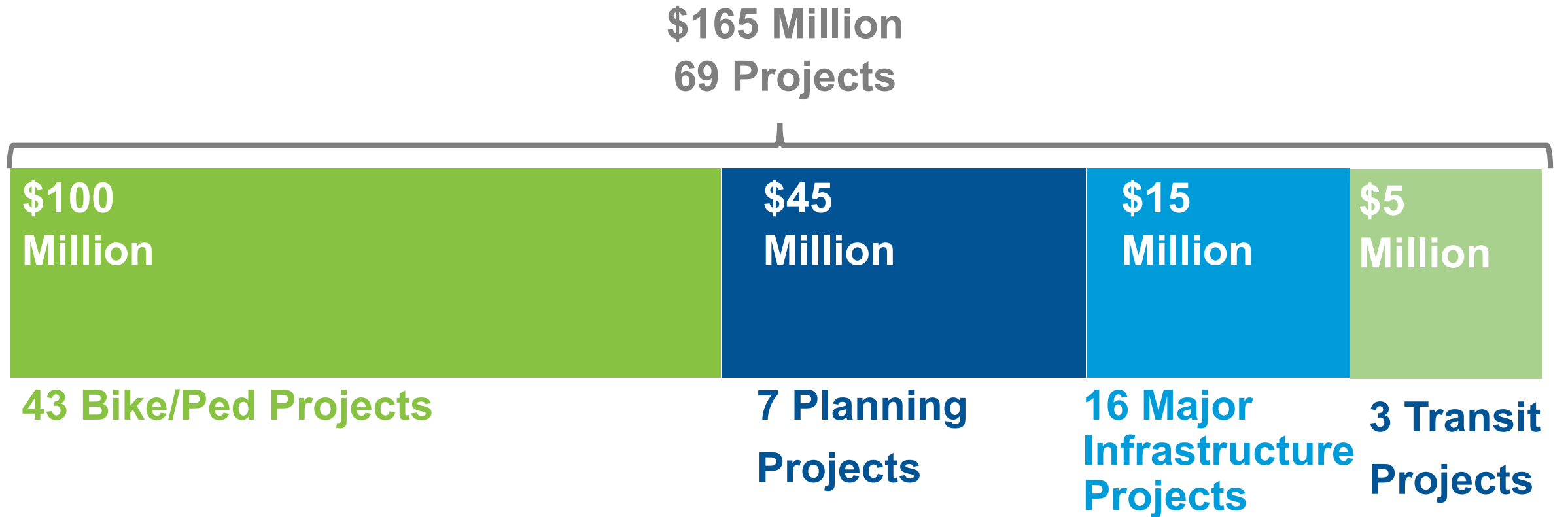
Funding Summary by Source
