 **RECOMMEND**

Recommended funding allocations within the available MAG, as provided by Broward County, are due to the MAP Administrator on June 1 annually. The revenue projections are provided by the Florida Department of Revenue.

The County Administrator is required to approve the *New MPO Evaluation and Ranking Process (New MPO E&R Process)* annually.

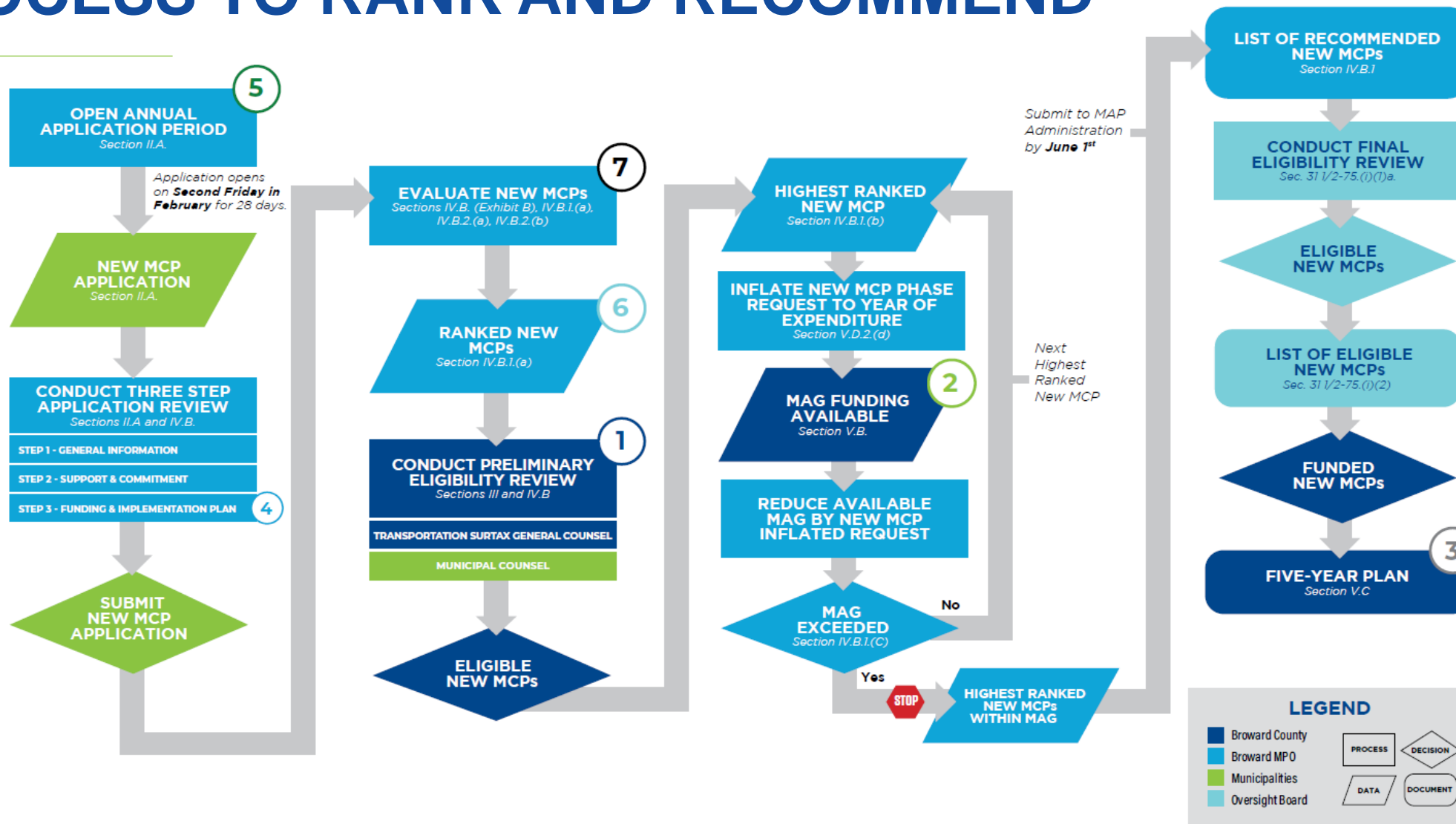
ROLE OF THE MPO

NEW MPO E&R PROCESS

Section IV.B

- 1 Preliminary eligibility review of each New MCP under Section 212.055, Florida Statutes, and Section III of the Second Amendment.
- 2 Annual evaluation of each New MCP application for MAG funding.
- 3 Evaluation of New MCPs for funding in the then-current fiscal year and the applicable Five-Year Plan.
- 4 Evaluation of the cost estimates provided by the municipalities.
- 5 Individual meetings with the municipalities to evaluate New MCP applications, funding needs, and sources of funding.
- 6 Rank New MCP applications per criteria (primary and secondary) listed in *Section IV.B.2*.
- 7 Score New MCP applications using a system like the one used to evaluate Cycle 1 MCPs (*Exhibit B* in the Second Amendment).

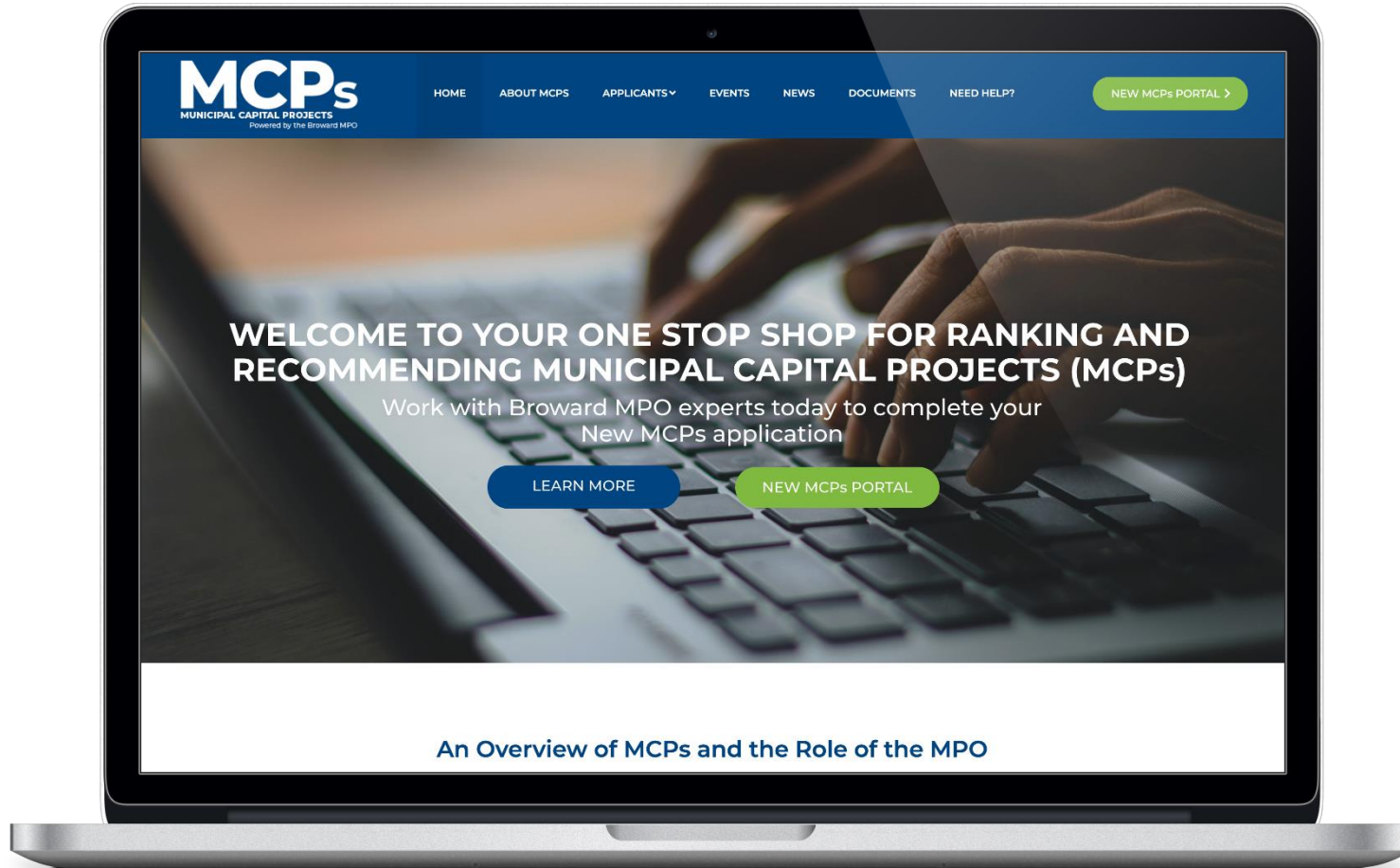

IMPORTANT DATES TO REMEMBER

- **February 10th** - New MCPs 2023 application period opened for 28 days. Municipalities may submit completed applications.
- **March 10th** - New MCPs 2023 application period closes. The submittal period ends at 5:00 PM EST.
- **June 1st** - A list of ranked New MCPs will be provided by the MPO to the MAP Administration (*Section IV.B.1 of the Second Amendment*).
