Noteworthy Practices

- **Transportation Planning Factors** – framework for the inclusion of climate change preparedness and resiliency into projects
- **Bicycle and Pedestrian Planning Activities** – Quick Build Program
BTactical
- **Transit** – increase mobility and connectivity through the Community Shuttle Program
- **Transit** – Mobility HUBs –transit access points with frequent transit service, high development potential and a critical point for trip generations or transfers

Noteworthy Practices

- **Freight Planning** – lead an effort to help the state identify high priority freight and rail projects that also satisfy local planning priorities
- **Safety Considerations in Planning** – Complete Streets 2021 Roadway Safety Award for the Complete Streets Master Plan
- **Outreach and Public Involvement** – Speak up Broward public engagement; Think Like a Planner workshops
- **Scope of LRTP** – ArcGIS tool to score and rank projects for objective evaluation of local projects for Accessibility, Safety, Equity, Mobility, Economic Vitality and Environmental Stewardship

Recommendations

- **Transit** – continue to coordinate on interoperability issue for seamless travel
- **L RTP Financial Plan/Fiscal Constraint** – include realistic project projections by time bands
- **L RTP Financial Plan/Fiscal Constraint** – reflect projected revenues from all sources beyond the TIP time band
- **L RTP Financial Plan/Fiscal Constraint** – include discussion of funding strategies that might be considered, but are not currently used
- **Transportation Improvement Program** – projects should not be added to the TIP before they are included in the LRTP
