Safe Streets & Roads for All (SS4A)



- Prioritized list and recommendations:
 - Safety Projects that address: Traffic Calming, Intersections, Technology Deployment, Complete Streets, Vision Zero, Railroad, Mid-block/Cyclist Crossings, Pilot Projects
 - Policy: Vision Zero, Complete Streets, Safe Speeds, Safe System Approach
- Prioritized list of projects will be generated with benefit/cost analysis
- Commitment to zero deaths and severe injuries with measurable goals

Railroad Crossing Elimination Program

- 80% Federal / 10% County / 10% City Funding
- Construction and coordination led by Brightline and BMPO
- Seeking funding agreements with cities for local match
- Reconfirming Scope
- Seeking funding agreements

Receiving Capacity Building, Planning and Technical Assistance

Complete Transit-Oriented Neighborhoods

- Summary of Important Dates & Next Steps:
 - Capacity Builders developing a Program Work Plan due to USDOT August 23rd
 - 90-day assessment starts after the work plan is submitted and approved
 - In Late August/Early September, Individual community kickoffs will be held with assigned Project Managers and Capacity Building Team.

PROTECT Planning Grant

The MPO is seeking a \$1.5 million dollar PROTECT Planning Grant.

- Develop a comprehensive Resiliency Improvement Plan (RIP) that identifies vulnerabilities in our transportation network, prioritizes these areas, and initiate pre-design work for the most vulnerable segments.
- Focuses on improving the safety of the transportation system, reducing damage and disruptions, and promoting equity by addressing the needs of disadvantaged communities that are often the most vulnerable to hazards.

Reconnecting Communities / Neighborhood Equity Access

- Planning grant to determine feasibility of linking roads below the RR corridor in Fort Lauderdale
- \$1.5M ask with Fort Lauderdale committing \$375K in local match
