**WHEREAS**, the Transportation Disadvantaged (TD) Local Coordinating Board (LCB) recognizes the statutory requirement for the designation of a Community Transportation Coordinator (CTC) by the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and,

**WHEREAS**, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners, through Broward County Transit (BCT), is currently the CTC and,

**WHEREAS**, the Broward County Board of County Commissioners is a local government entity and,


**WHEREAS**, the LCB has received quarterly status reports from the CTC Paratransit Manager; reviewed and approved coordination contracts; worked cooperatively with the CTC Paratransit Manager and staff to create local standards, review policies and review procedures, and,

**WHEREAS**, the LCB developed and validated the CTC Evaluation to be reviewed by the MPO in June 2025 and,

**WHEREAS**, the LCB, as a group and as individuals, is cognizant of the quality of the paratransit services currently offered by the CTC,

**NOW THEREFORE**, does the LCB endorse the action of the Metropolitan Planning Organization in submitting to the State of Florida its recommendation that the Broward County Board of County Commissioners, through BCT, be designated to discharge the duties of Community Transportation Coordinator.
