## April 10, 2025 MPO Board Meeting: Action Items

The following items were approved at the April 10, 2025 Broward MPO Board meeting:

### **Broward MPO Strategic Business Plan Update**

The updated Strategic Business Plan will continue to align MPO staff with the strategic directions and goals of the MPO Board.

### **GPC Task Work Order No. 21 Between the Broward MPO and Kimley-Horn & Associates, Inc. for Infrastructure Hardening: SR-A1A from Hallandale Beach Boulevard to South of Arizona Street in an Amount Not to Exceed \$149,971.38**

Kimley-Horn will provide professional expertise and technical assistance implementing the MPO's Infrastructure Hardening framework study along State Road (SR)-A1A in the City of Hollywood from Hallandale Beach Boulevard to South of Arizona Street.

### **GPC Task Work Order No. 24 Between Broward MPO and Kimley-Horn & Associates, Inc. For Fort Lauderdale Roadway-Railroad Underpass Feasibility Study in an Amount Not to Exceed \$1,679,959.58**

Kimley-Horn will conduct a planning study that will evaluate the feasibility of improvements at five at-grade railroad crossings along the Florida East Coast Railway in the City of Fort Lauderdale by tunneling under the railroad to reduce road congestion.

### **Interlocal Agreement Between the Broward MPO and the City of Hallandale Beach, Florida for Transportation Planning and Related Services**

The City will now be able to issue mutually agreed upon task work orders to the MPO for transportation planning services on an as-needed basis.

### **Assignment of Agreement No. 24-01 Between Broward MPO and Cherry Bekaert Advisory LLC for Financial and Accounting Services for Metro Transportation Engineering and Construction Cooperative (MTECC)**

MTECC will assume the obligations of the MPO with regard to the Financial and Accounting Services Agreement with Cherry Bekaert Advisory LLC going forward.

### **Approve Any and All Edits, Scrivener Errors, and Other Non-substantive Revisions to Broward MPO Core Products and Other Active Related Documents Adopted by the BMPO Board to Comply With Current or Otherwise Modified Federal Policies**

Necessary edits and non-substantive revisions to MPO core products previously approved by the MPO Board will be presented to the Executive Committee for approvals.

### **Broward Safety Action Plan (BSAP) Executive Plan**

Local agency partners in Broward County will now be able to apply for Safe Streets and Roads for All Implementation Grant funding during the 2025 funding cycle.

## April 10, 2025 MPO Board Meeting: Non Action Items

The April 10, 2025 Broward MPO Board meeting non-action items are summarized below:

### **Roads for Economic Vitality (REV) Program Update**

MPO staff provided an update on the REV program (formerly known as the Complete Streets and Other Localized Initiatives Program or CSLIP). Due to the REV program and policies currently undergoing a much-needed major update to address current United States Department of Transportation policies, Local Agency Program project delivery, funding, and project prioritization analysis, the MPO will not conduct a 2025 REV award cycle.

MPO staff will work directly with the MPO's advisory committees and MPO Board to refine the policies, prioritization criteria, and process to address local needs and policy direction at the State and Federal levels. These will come back for action at a future MPO Board meeting.

### **Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) - Stirling Road (SR 848) and Florida's Turnpike (SR 91) at Milepost (MP) 52 Project Development & Environment (PD&E) Study**

FTE staff presented on the preferred alternatives of interchange configurations along the Turnpike and Stirling Road.
