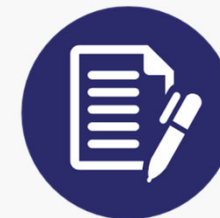

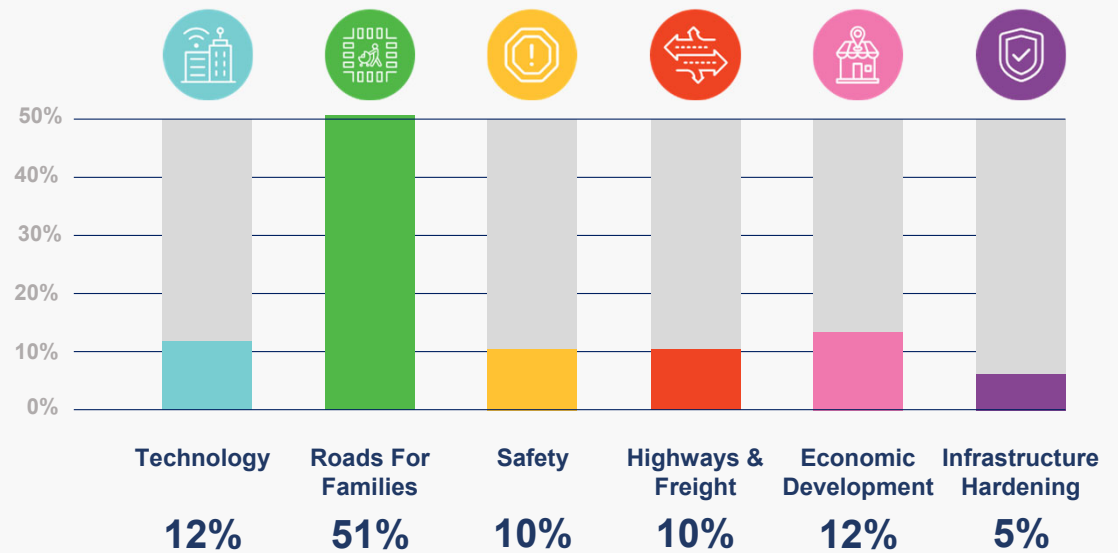



The LOPP is organized by six funding programs. It utilizes the 2050 MTP's allocations for the Broward MPO's attributable funds.
