

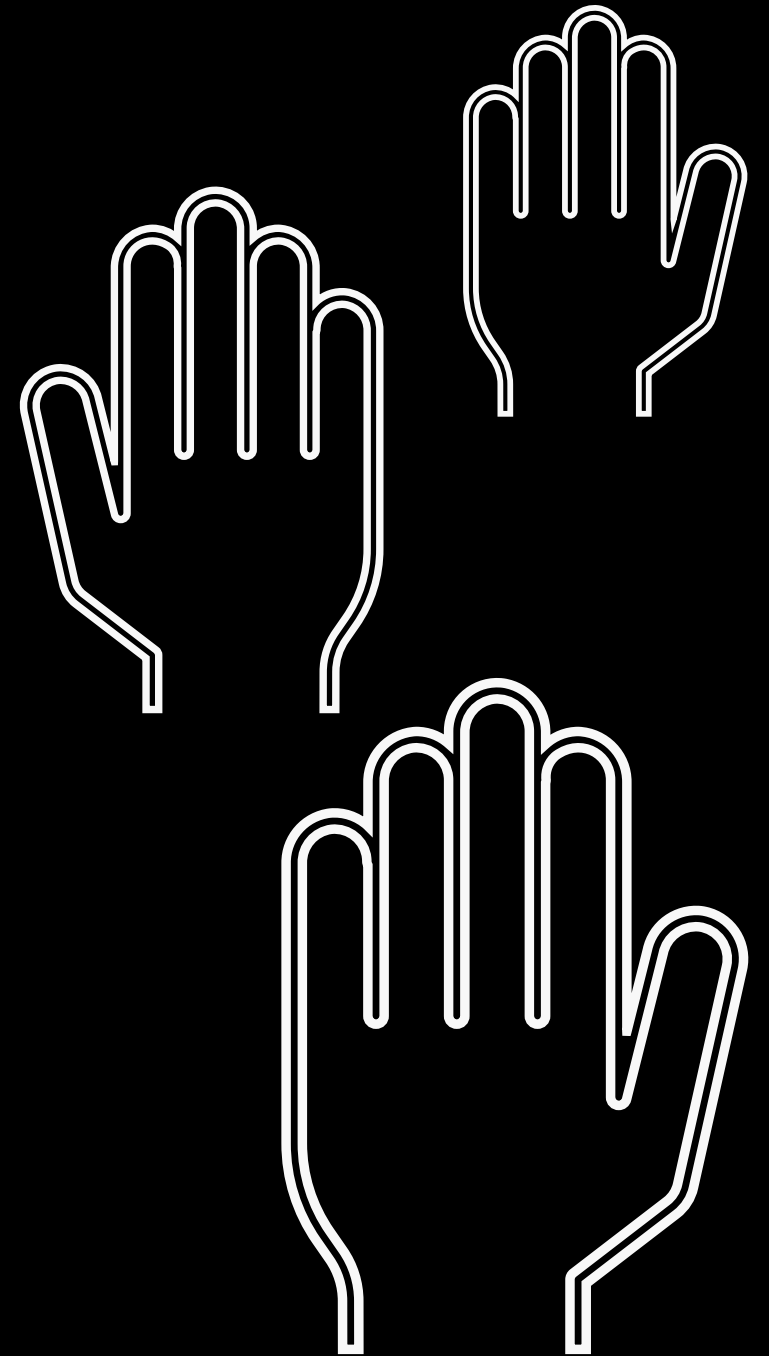

What is Micromobility?

As defined by Florida Statute 316.003

A motorized transportation device designed for individual use which is typically 20 to 36 inches in width and 50 pounds or less in weight and which operates at a **speed of typically less than 15 miles per hour but no more than 28 miles per hour**. This term both human-powered and nonhuman powered device such as bicycle, electric bicycle, motorized scooter, or any other device that is owned by an individual or part of a shared fleet.

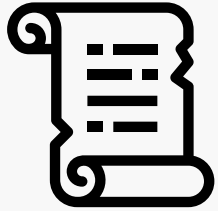

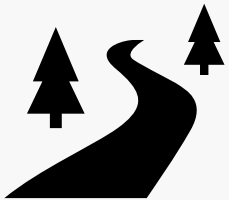
Safety & Education
