July 9, 2026 MPO Board Meeting: Action Items

The following items were approved at the July 9, 2026 Broward MPO Board meeting:

Government Public Involvement Services Task Work Order (TWO) No. 8 Between the Broward MPO and The Brand Advocates for Event Management Support in a Total Amount Not to Exceed \$76,050

The Brand Advocates will develop in-person and virtual events and provide strategic communications and public outreach support for the 2055 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) and other Broward MPO plans and studies.

Amendment No. 1 to GPC TWO No. 12 Between the Broward MPO and Whitehouse Group, Inc. for Florida Metropolitan Planning Organization Advisory Council's (MPOAC) Freight and Rail Committee Support in a Total Amount Not to Exceed \$269,540.01

Whitehouse Group will continue to provide support services to the Florida MPOAC Freight and Rail Committee until June 30, 2027, at a cost of \$95,000, bringing to the total not-to-exceed amount for the TWO to \$269,540.01.

Amendment No. 1 to GPC TWO No. 14 Between the Broward MPO and Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. for Planning & Engineering Assistance for Off-System Local Agency Program (LAP) Project Development in a Total Amount Not to Exceed \$1,039,008.21

Kimley-Horn will provide professional planning and pre-engineering assistance for two additional LAP projects identified in the MTP until December 31, 2027, at a cost of \$299,951.13, bringing to the total not-to-exceed amount for the TWO to \$1,039,008.21.

Amendment No. 1 to GPC TWO No. 17 Between the Broward MPO and Kittelson & Associates, Inc. for Citywide Transportation Master Plans (TMP) in a Total Amount Not to Exceed \$424,841.20

Kittelson will provide planning technical assistance for up to one additional TMP until December 31, 2027, at a cost of \$174,841.26, bringing to the total not-to-exceed amount for the TWO to \$424,841.20.

Executive Committee Recommendations Regarding General Counsel Performance Review

General Counsel's satisfactory rating by the Executive Committee was accepted by the MPO Board.

Executive Committee Recommendation Regarding Executive Director's Performance Review

The Executive Director's satisfactory rating by the Executive Committee was accepted by the MPO Board.

Draft FY 2027-2031 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

The approved \$4.7 billion TIP includes highway, transit, rail, aviation and seaport, as well as bicycle, pedestrian and freight-related projects to be implemented over the next five years.

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July 9, 2026 MPO Board Meeting: Non-Action Items

The July 9, 2026 Broward MPO Board meeting non-action items are summarized below:

Broward MPO Performance Measures Dashboard & State of the System Report

MPO staff provided a demonstration of the performance measures dashboard and State of the System Report which provides MPO staff with the ability to share information about the Federally mandated performance measures with the MPO Board, its committees, and the public in an easy and visually pleasing manner.

Introduction to Micromobility

MPO staff provided a presentation on micromobility: what it is, concerns surrounding it, and what actions are currently being taken. This includes State regulations, details on devices that are considered micromobility versus those that are not, concerns about safety, infrastructure, and inconsistency in rules and regulations among municipalities.
