WHEREAS, The Burnet County Commissioners' Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Burnet County that *the Burnet County Sheriff's Office* operate the Burnet County Courthouse Metal Detector and Panic Button Project grant during October 1, 2024 – September 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, The Burnet County Commissioners' Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, The Burnet County Commissioners' Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full.
