



FY 2025 VICTIM ASSISTANCE, FIRST RESPONDER PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Burnet County Commissioners' Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Burnet County that *the Burnet County Sheriff's Office* operate the Burnet County LEO Mental Health Deputy and Counseling Services Program during October 1, 2024 – September 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Burnet County agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the FY 25 Victim Assistance, First Responder Programs grant application; and

WHEREAS, The Burnet County Commissioners' Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds, The Burnet County Commissioners' Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Officer of the Governor in full.

WHEREAS, The Burnet County Commissioners' Court designates the Burnet County Pct 4 Commissioner as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.
