Thank you for your question regarding the Bluebonnet Trails Community Services Senate Bill 292 (SB 292) grant funding supporting crisis diversion services in Burnet County. The Burnet County crisis diversion/mental health deputy program has been funded through a SB 292 grant award to Bluebonnet Trails Community Services. This grant funding was initiated by the 85th Texas Legislative Session during 2016.

No, the funding will not continue for FY 2025. As the 2024 re-application made by Bluebonnet Trails Community Services seeking ongoing funding for Burnet County was not awarded by the Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC), the current SB 292 funding awarded to Bluebonnet Trails Community Services supports the Burnet County crisis diversion/mental health deputy program **through August 31, 2024.**

In other words, the funding agreement ends on August 31, 2024. Please let me know if additional information may be helpful.
