

system overview

In "Build" the generation of the Paper Mail Ballots and the vDrives that are used to set up the election equipment going to polling locations is performed.



Paper Ballots and vDrives



Voted mail ballots are scanned by the Central scanner at the Elections office.

central scanning



The Verity Count system in the Elections office is where the vDrives from polling locations and from the Central Mail Ballot Scanner are read and the votes are tallied on election night.



Ultimately, every voted paper ballot is retained as a backup for the election!

Election data is manually entered to design the ballots and to integrate the ballot styles.



polling place



At the polling locations, ballots are printed for each voter or the voter can choose to use a ballot marking device that then prints the ballot. Then the voter inserts the ballot into the scanner.
