Requested Water Area 1 in Burnet County: Quail Creek Subdivision

The requested water area 1 is located approximately 7.3 miles southeast of downtown Marble Falls, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by State Highway 71; on the east by County Road 409A; on the south by Little Cypress Creek; and on the west by approximately 585 feet west of County Road 425.

The requested water area 1 includes 39 customer connections and approximately 92.3 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983.

Requested Water Area 2 in Washington County: NE Washington County NE WC

The requested water area 2 is located approximately 1.6 miles northeast of downtown Brenham, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Burleson and Washington County Line; on the east by Grimes and Washington County Line; on the south by Mustang Road; and on the west by State Highway 36.

The requested water area 2 includes 1,054 customer connections and approximately 73,910.4 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983. The requested water area 2 also includes 151,503.3 linear feet to transfer from the CCN No. 13227 (facilities + 200 feet) to CCN No. 12983 (facilities + 200 feet).

Requested Water Area 3 in Washington County: Gun & Rod Subdivision

The requested water area 3 is located approximately 2.2 miles southeast of downtown Brenham, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Mustang Road; on the east by Woodward Creek; on the south by Farm to Market Road 577; and on the west by Farm to Market Road 577.

The requested water area 3 includes 72 customer connections and approximately 71.3 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983.

Requested Water Area 4 in Burnet County: Lake Buchanan Subdivision

The requested water area 4 is located approximately 9 miles west of downtown Burnet, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by State Highway 29; on the east by Clear Creek; on the south by Long Mountain Drive; and on the west by County Road 141.

The requested water area 4 includes 132 customer connections and approximately 306.9 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983.

Requested Water Areas 5 and 6 in Mitchell County:

The requested water areas 5 and 6 are located approximately 0.7 miles south from downtown Colorado City, Texas, and are generally bounded on the north by County Road 143; on the east by County Road 412; on the south by Beals Creek and County Road 337; and on the west by County Road 268.

The requested water areas 5 and 6 include 750 customer connections and approximately 50,199.4 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983. The requested water areas 5 and 6 also includes 3,684 linear feet to transfer from CCN No. 13227 (facilities + 200 feet) to CCN No. 12983 (facilities + 200 feet). Due to pre-existing dual certification between City of Colorado City (CCN No. 10222) and CCN No. 13227, 1,448.8 acres will have dual certification between CCN No. 10222 and CCN No. 12983 as a result of this transfer.

Requested Water Area 7 in Colorado County: Alleyton

The requested water area 7 is located approximately 2.1 miles east of downtown Columbus, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Reese Lane; on the east by Sandy Branch; on the south by Colorado River; on the west by Commerce Lane.

The requested water area 7 includes 68 customer connections and approximately 629.8 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983.

Requested Water Area 8 in Llano County: Lake Buchanan

The requested water area 8 is located approximately 11.9 miles east of downtown Llano, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Buchanan Lake; on the east by Long Mountain Drive; on the south by County Road 302; and on the west by Sandy Creek.

The requested water area 8 includes 627 customer connections and approximately 3,617.3 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983.

Requested Water Area 9 in Llano County: Paradise Point Subdivision

The requested water area 9 is located approximately 16.1 miles northeast of Llano, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Elliott Drive; on the east by Buchanan Lake; on the south by Buchanan Lake; and on the west by Village Drive.

The requested water area 9 includes 122 customer connections and approximately 103.8 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983.

Requested Water Area 10 in Burnet County: Spicewood Beach/Lakeside Beach Subdivision

The requested water area 10 is located approximately 8 miles southeast of Marble Falls, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Colorado River; on the east by Lake Travis; on the south by State Highway 71; and on the west by County Road 407.

The requested water area 10 includes 549 customer connections and approximately 1,377.4 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983.

Requested Water Area 11 in Burnet and Travis Counties: Ridge Harbor Subdivision

The requested water area 11 is located approximately 5.2 miles northwest of downtown Briarcliff, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Lake Travis; on the east by Burnet and Travis County Line; on the south by County Road 420; on the west by County Road 412.

The requested water area 11 includes 206 customer connections and approximately 433.8 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983.

Requested Water Area 12 in Burnet County: Smithwick Mills Community

The requested water area 12 is located approximately 6.2 miles southeast of downtown Marble Falls, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Ranch to Market Road 1431; on the east by County Road 344; on the south by Lake Travis; and on the west by Lake Travis.

The requested water area 12 includes 77 customer connections and approximately 206.5 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983.

Requested Water Area 13 in Burnet, Lampasas, Mills, and San Saba Counties: Lometa Regional Water

The requested water area 13 is located approximately 2.5 miles northwest of downtown Lampasas, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Farm to Market Road 572; on the east by United States Highway 281; on the south by Farm to Market Road 1478; on the west by Farm to Market Road 1031.

The requested water area 13 includes 1,229 customer connections and approximately 255,239.4 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983. Due to pre-existing dual certification between Lower Colorado River Authority (CCN No. 11670) and CCN No. 13227, 24.3 acres will have dual certification between CCN No. 11670 and CCN No. 12983 as a result of this transfer.

Requested Water Area 14 in Matagorda County: Matagorda Dunes

The requested water area 14 is located approximately 15.7 miles southeast of downtown Palacios, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by approximately 1.5 miles north of the intersection of Beach Front Drive and Farm to Market Road 2301; on the east by Matagorda County Line; on the south by Matagorda County Line; on the west by Colorado River.

The requested water area 14 includes 144 customer connections and approximately 458.7 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983.

Requested Water Area 15 in Blanco and Burnet Counties: Summit Springs Subdivision

The requested water area 15 is located approximately 5.5 miles northeast of downtown Round Mountain, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by State Highway 71; on the east by Little Cypress Creek; on the south by Fall Creek; and on the west by Shovel Mountain Road.

The requested water area 15 includes 124 customer connections and approximately 859.3 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983.

Requested Water Area 16 in Burnet County: Bonanza Beach Subdivision

The requested water area 16 is located approximately 10 miles northwest of downtown Burnet, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Ranch to Market Road 2341; on the east by Adams Creek; on the south by Buchanan Lake; and on the west by Buchanan Lake.

The requested water area 16 includes 55 customer connections and approximately 54.9 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983.

Requested Water Area 17 in Llano County: Tow Village Subdivision

The requested water area 17 is located approximately 16.5 miles northeast of downtown Llano, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Fall Creek; on the east by Buchanan Lake; on the south by Buchanan Lake; and on the west by County Road 222.

The requested water area 17 includes 27 customer connections and approximately 48.8 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983. Due to pre-existing dual certification between Silver Creek Village WSC (CCN No. 11709) and CCN No. 13227, 46.7 acres will have dual certification between CCN No. 11709 and CCN No. 12983 as a result of this transfer.

Requested Water Area 18 in Llano County: Sandy Harbor Subdivision

The requested water area 18 is located approximately 2 miles south of downtown Sunrise Beach Village, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Sandy Creek; on the east by The Trails Parkway; on the south by Sandy Harbor Drive; and on the west by Walnut Creek.

The requested water area 18 includes 122 customer connections and approximately 167.1 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983.

Requested Water Area 19 in Blanco County: Trinity Oaks Subdivision

The requested water area 19 is located approximately 2 miles north of downtown Round Mountain, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by East Ranch Road; on the east by Old Marble Falls Road; on the south by Lincoln Smith Road; and on the west by United States Highway 281.

The requested water area 19 includes 23 customer connections and approximately 131.4 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983.

Requested Water Area 20 in Bastrop County: Windmill Subdivision

The requested water area 20 is located approximately 3.6 miles southeast of Webberville, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Colorado River; on the east by Moccasin Canyon Road; on the south by Sabine Drive; and on the west by Colorado Drive.

The requested water area 20 includes 148 customer connections and approximately 195.9 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983.

Total Requested Water Areas 1 – 20:

The total requested water areas (1-20) include 5,568 customer connections and approximately 388,104.4 acres to transfer from CCN No. 13227 to CCN No. 12983. The total requested water areas (1-20) also include 155,187.3 linear feet to transfer from CCN No. 13227 (facilities + 200 feet) to CCN No. 12983 (facilities + 200 feet).

The application proposes the subtraction of approximately 388,104.4 acres from CCN No. 13227 and the addition of approximately 388,104.4 acres to CCN No. 12983. The application also proposes the subtraction of approximately 155,187.3 linear feet from CCN No. 13227 and the addition of approximately 155,187.3 linear feet to CCN No. 12983.

Due to pre-existing dual certification between City of Colorado City (CCN No. 10222) and CCN No. 13227, 1,448.8 acres will have dual certification between CCN No. 10222 and CCN No. 12983 as a result of this transfer.

Due to pre-existing dual certification between Lower Colorado River Authority (CCN No. 11670) and CCN No. 13227, 24.3 acres will have dual certification between CCN No. 11670 and CCN No. 12983 as a result of this transfer.

Due to pre-existing dual certification between Silver Creek Village WSC (CCN No. 11709) and CCN No. 13227, 46.7 acres will have dual certification between CCN No. 11709 and CCN No. 12983 as a result of this transfer.

Requested Sewer Area 1 in Bastrop County: Double Eagle Ranch Subdivision, Lake Bastrop Acres Subdivision, LCRA Nature Preserve, Bastrop ISD, & Los Pines Hyatt

The requested sewer area 1 is located approximately 2.2 miles northwest of downtown Bastrop, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Dogwood Creek; on the east by State Highway 21; on the south by State Highway 71; on the west by Colorado Drive.

The requested sewer area 1 includes 512 customer connections and approximately 36,863 acres to transfer from CCN No. 21081 to CCN No. 20899. Due to pre-existing dual certification between XS Ranch MUD (CCN No. 21087) and CCN No. 21081, 7,121.7 acres will have dual certification between CCN No. 21087 and CCN No. 20899 as a result of this transfer.

Requested Sewer Area 2 in Colorado County: Alleyton

The requested sewer area 2 is located approximately 2.1 miles east of downtown Columbus, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Reese Lane; on the east by Sandy Branch; on the south by Colorado River; on the west by Commerce Lane.

The requested sewer area 2 includes 89 customer connections and approximately 629.8 acres to transfer from CCN No. 21081 to CCN No. 20899.

Requested Water Sewer Area 3 in Burnet and Travis Counties: Ridge Harbor Subdivision

The requested sewer area 3 is located approximately 5.2 miles northwest of downtown Briarcliff, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Lake Travis; on the east by Burnet and Travis County Line; on the south by County Road 420; on the west by County Road 412.

The requested sewer area 3 includes 174 customer connections and approximately 372.4 acres to transfer from CCN No. 21081 to CCN No. 20899.

Requested Sewer Area 4 in Lampasas County: Lometa Regional Water

The requested sewer area 4 is located approximately 15.7 miles northwest of downtown Lampasas, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Farm to Market Road 581; on the east by County Road 2001; on the south by County Road 2102; on the west by United States Highway 190.

The requested sewer area 4 includes 290 customer connections and approximately 583.1 acres to transfer from CCN No. 21081 to CCN No. 20899.

Requested Water Sewer Area 5 in Matagorda County: Matagorda Dunes

The requested sewer area 5 is located approximately 15.7 miles southeast of downtown Palacios, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by approximately 1.5 miles north of the intersection of Beach Front Drive and Farm to Market Road 2301; on the east by Matagorda County Line; on the south by Matagorda County Line; on the west by Colorado River.

The requested sewer area 5 includes 48 customer connections and approximately 458.7 acres to transfer from CCN No. 21081 to CCN No. 20899.

Requested Sewer Area 6 in Hays County: HEB Nutty Brown

The requested sewer area 6 is located approximately 2.2 miles northwest of downtown Bear Creek, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by United States Highway 290; on the east by Rim Rock Trail; by on the south by Kit Carson Road; on the west by Nutty Brown Road.

The requested sewer area 6 includes 1 customer connections and approximately 60.6 acres to transfer from CCN No. 21081 to CCN No. 20899.

Requested Sewer Area 7 in Bastrop County: Stony Point and Elm Ridge Subdivision

The requested sewer area 7 is located approximately 8.8 miles northeast of downtown Mustang Ridge, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by approximately 155 feet north of High Point Boulevard; on the east by approximately 150 feet east of Oak River Drive; on the south by Maha Creek; and on the west by Wolf Lane.

The requested sewer area 7 includes 546 customer connections and approximately 256.9 acres to transfer from CCN No. 21081 to CCN No. 20899.

Total Requested Sewer Areas 1 – 7:

The total requested sewer areas (1-7) include 1,660 customer connections and approximately 39,224.5 acres to transfer from CCN No. 21081 to CCN No. 20899.

The application proposes the subtraction of approximately 39,224.5 acres from CCN No. 21081 and the addition of approximately 39,224.5 acres to CCN No. 20899.

Due to pre-existing dual certification between XS Ranch MUD (CCN No. 21087) and CCN No. 21081, 7,121.7 acres will have dual certification between CCN No. 21087 and CCN No. 20899 as a result of this transfer.

This transaction will not have an effect on the current customer's rates and services.

Persons who wish to intervene in the proceeding or comment upon action sought should contact the Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 13326, Austin, Texas 78711-3326, or call the Public Utility Commission at (512) 936-7120 or (888) 782-8477. Hearing- and speech-impaired individuals may contact the commission through Relay Texas at 1-800-735-2989. The deadline for intervention in the proceeding is (30 days from the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer). You must send a letter requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date.*

The letter must include the person's name, address, email address, and fax number, if applicable.

**Hearing- and speech-impaired individuals with text telephones (TTY) may alternatively contact the commission directly at (512) 936-7136.*

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will refer the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for a final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.

A landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the requested area, may file a written request with the Commission to be excluded from the requested area ("opt-out") within 30 days from the date that notice was provided by the Utility. All landowner opt-out requests must include the commission docket number, CCN number, the total acreage to remove from the requested area, a sealed or embossed metes and bounds description or survey of the landowner's tract of land, and the landowner's name, address, email address and fax number, if applicable.

A landowner that opts out from the requested area releases the applicant's obligation to provide retail water and/or sewer utility service to the removed land for any reason.

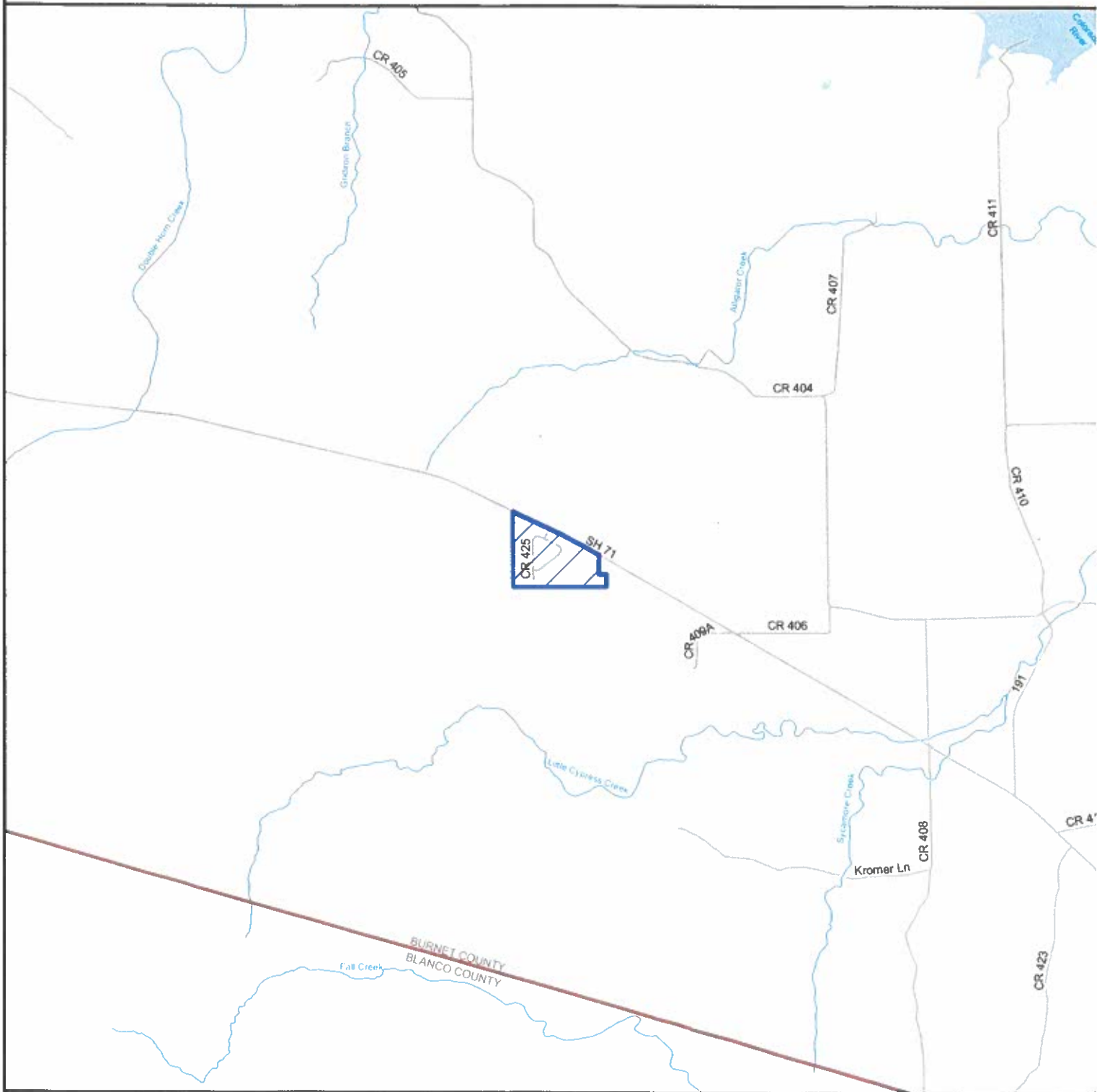

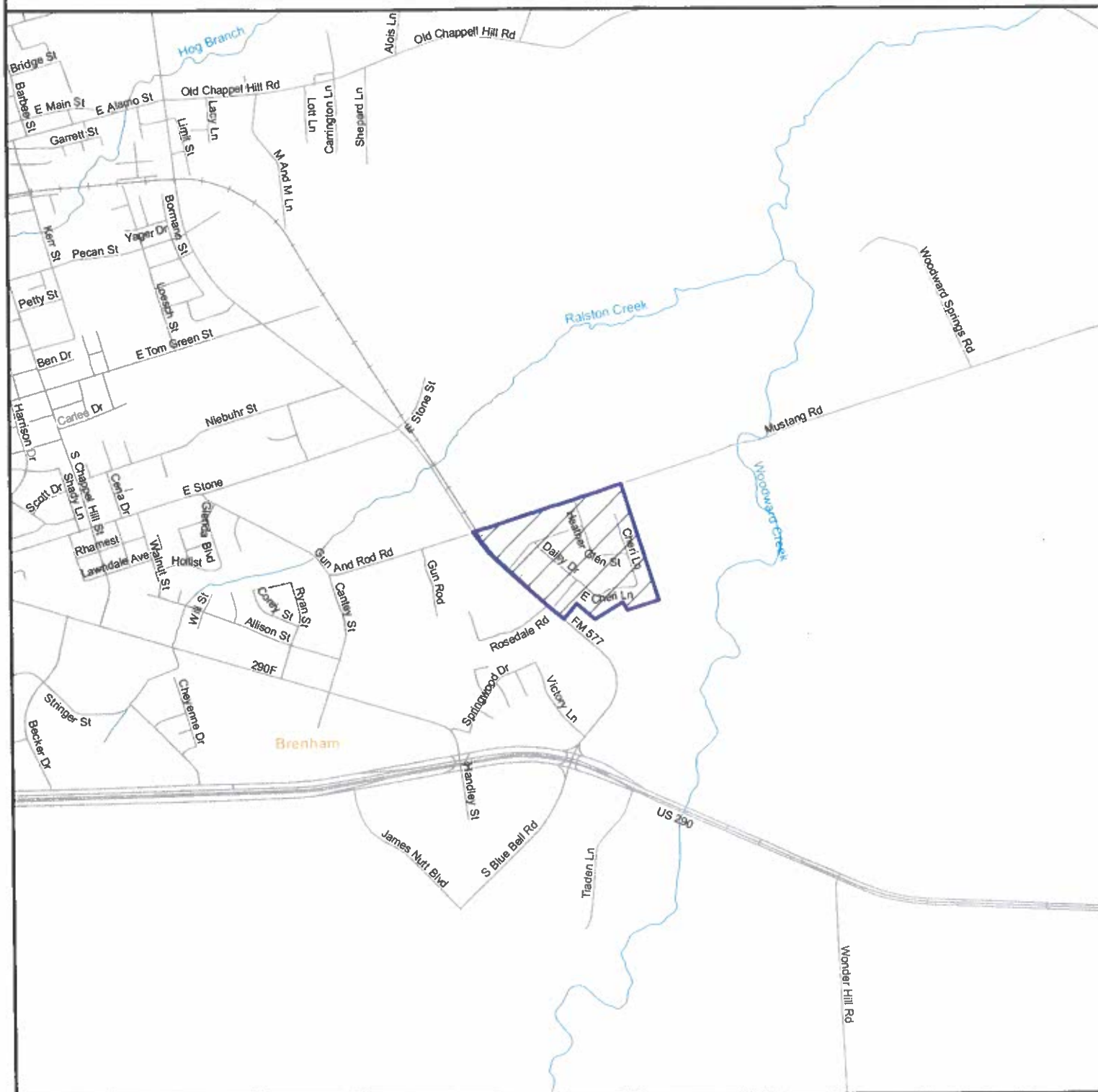

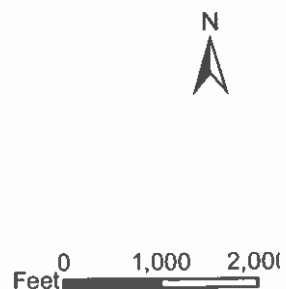

Gun & Rod**

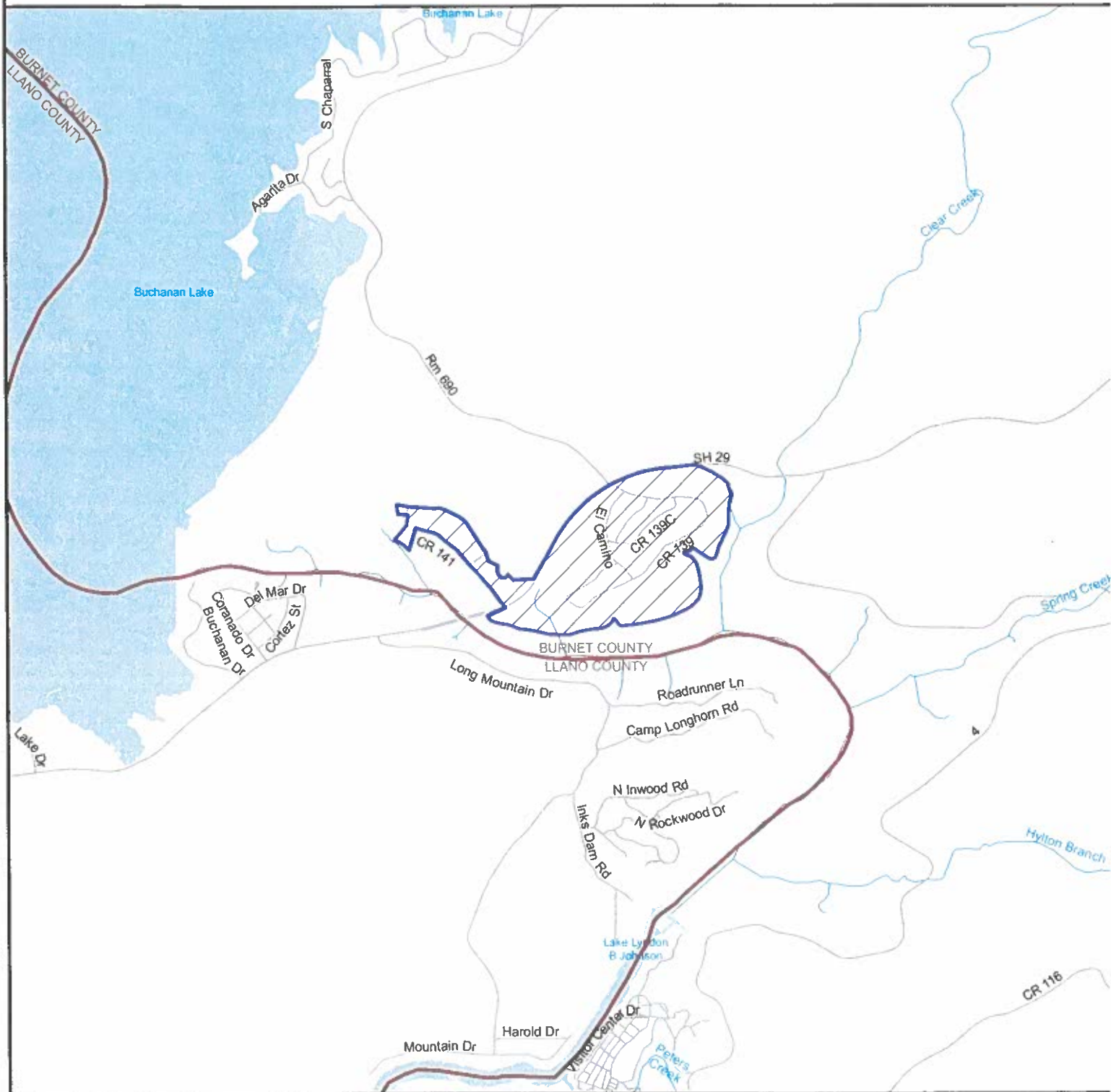

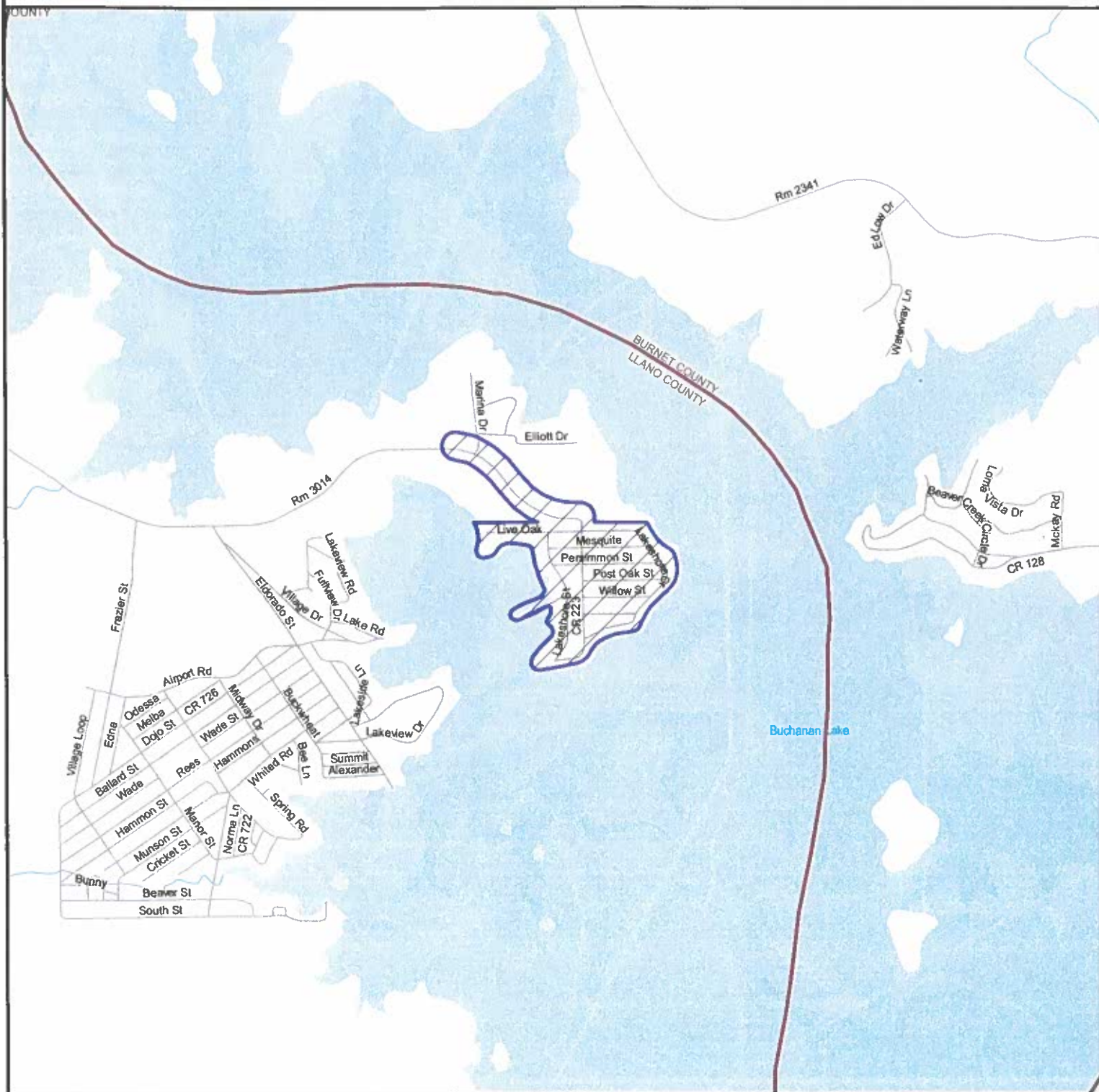

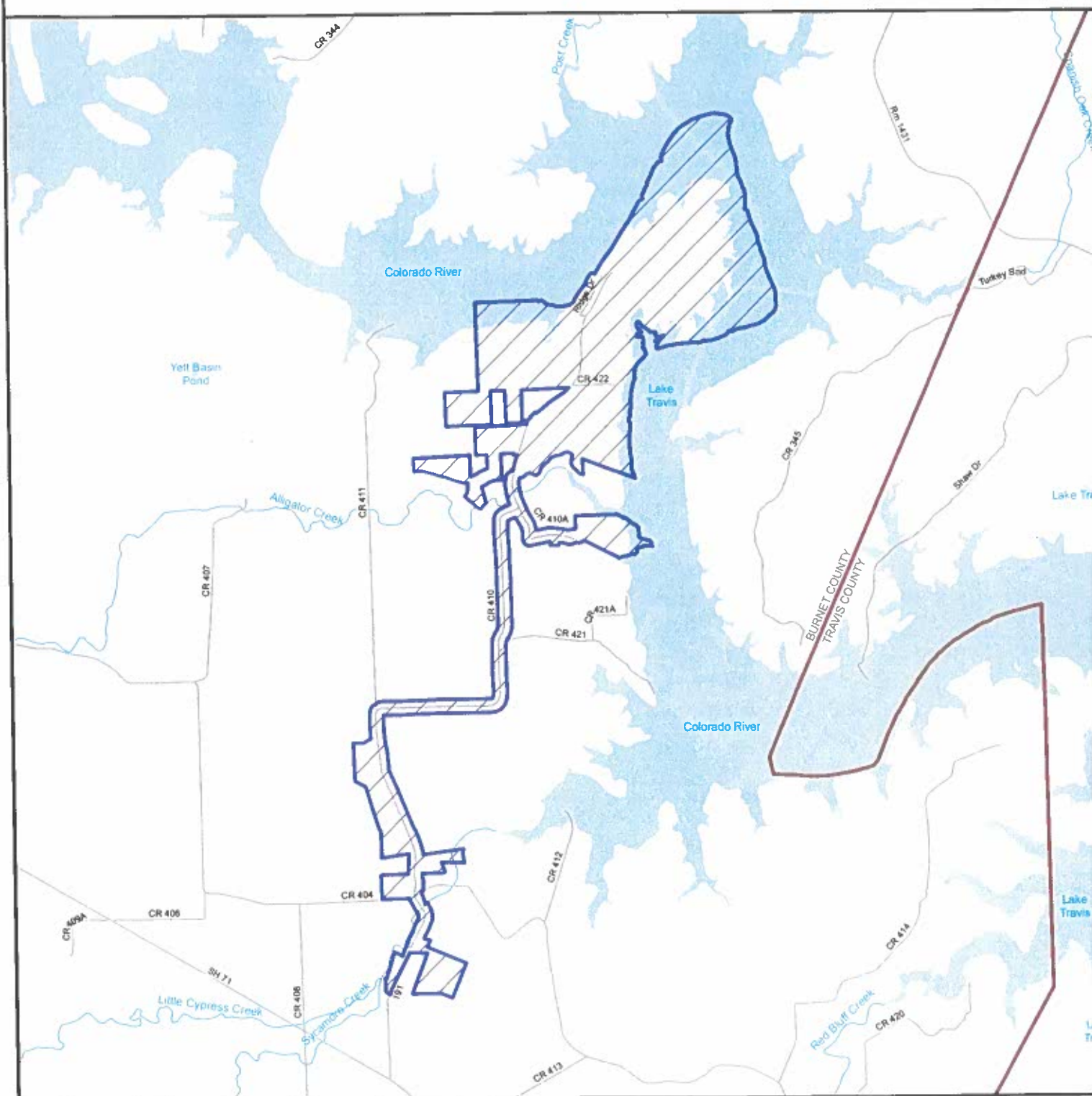

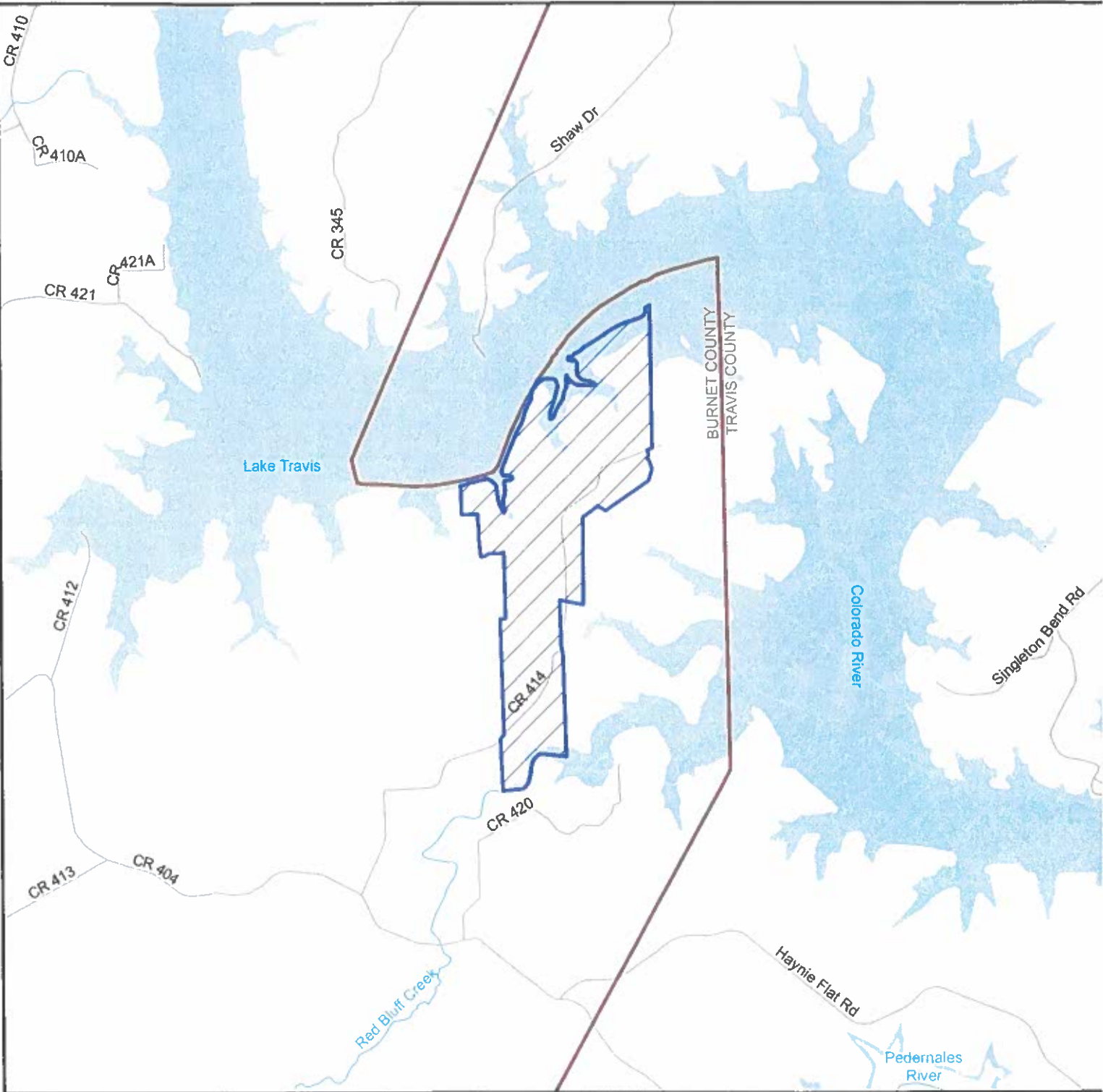

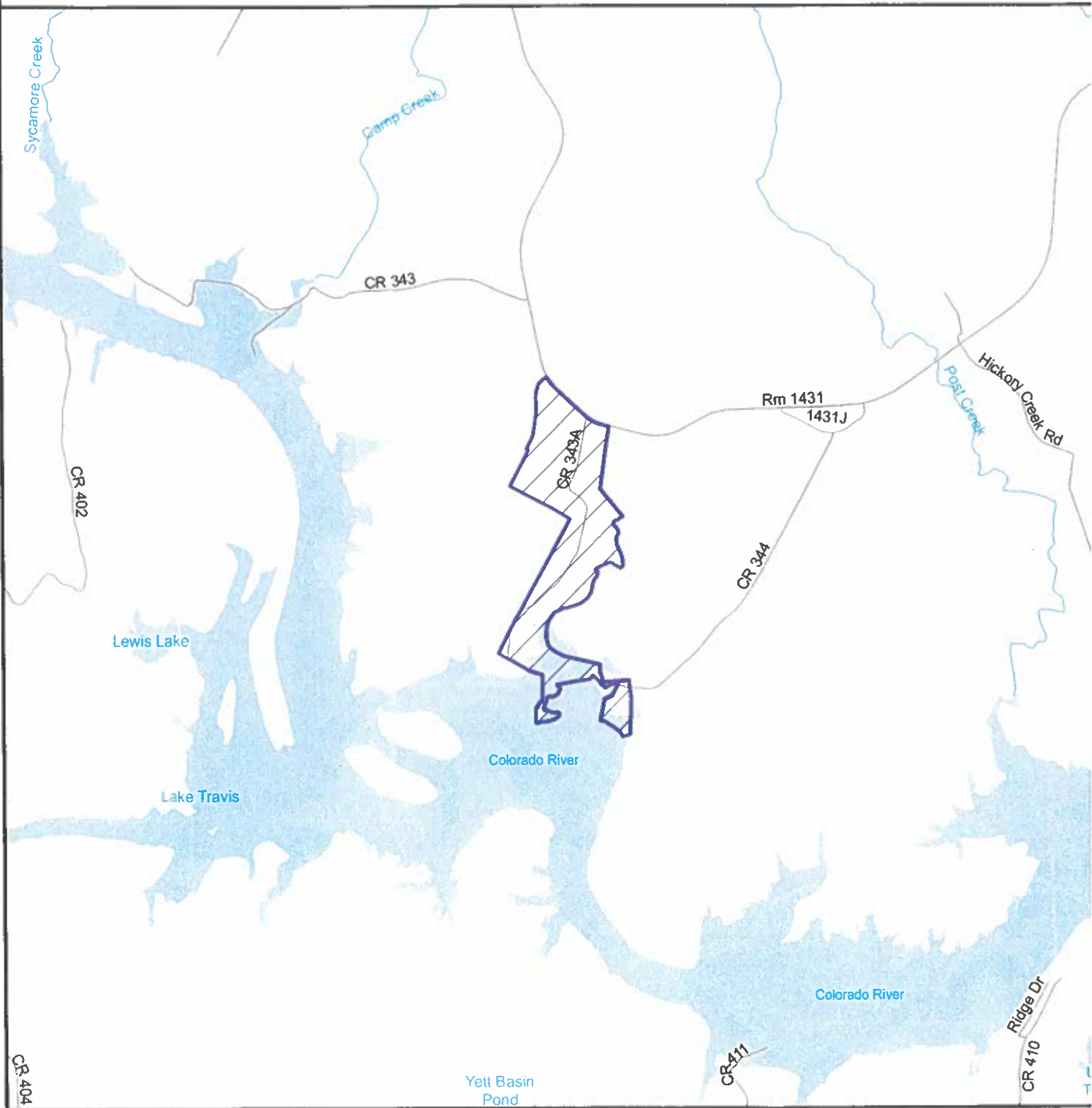

Lometa Regional Water**

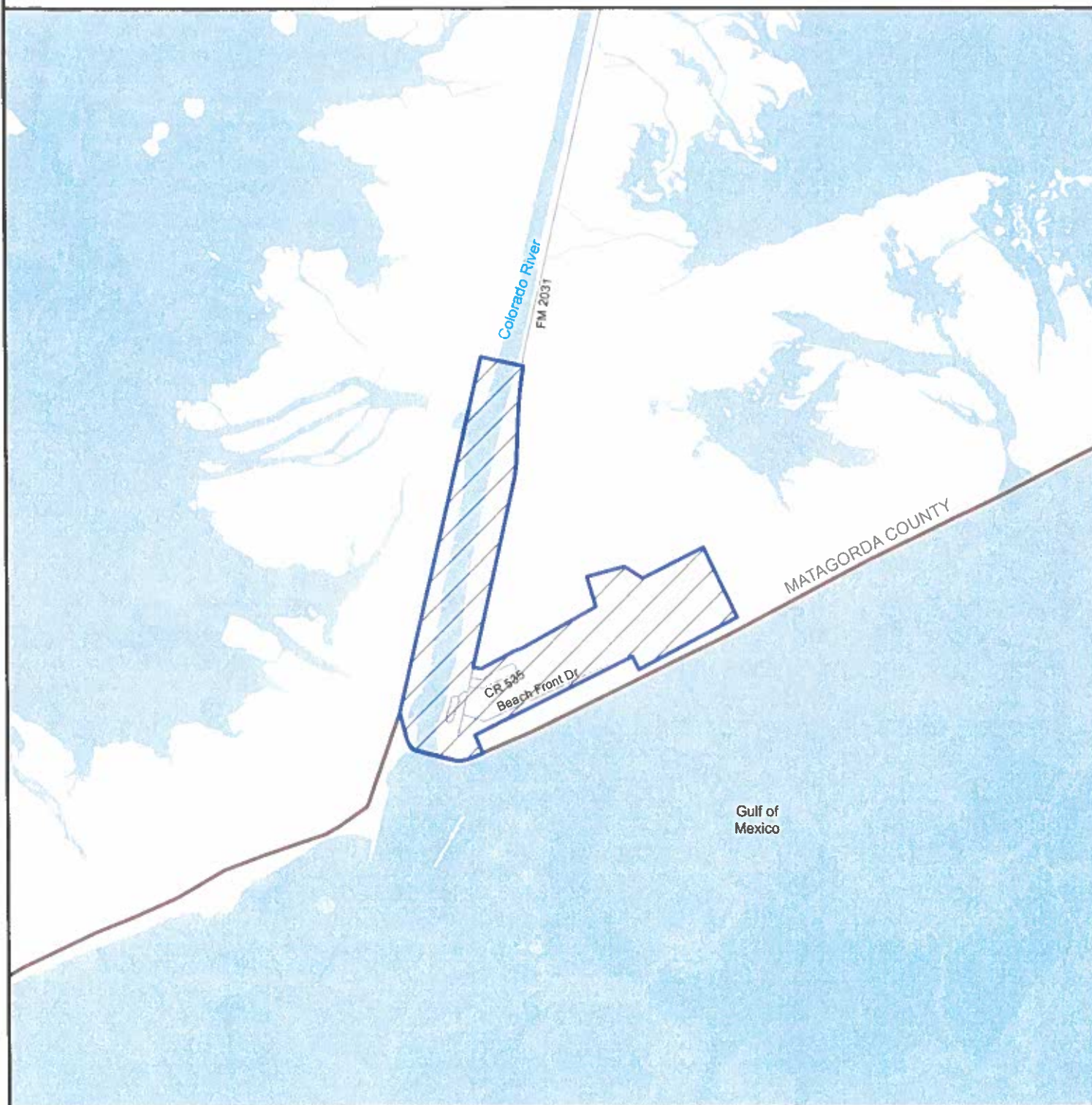

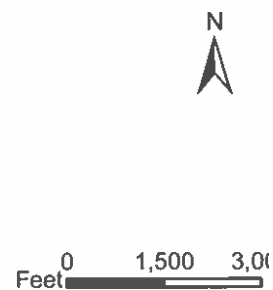

Matagorda Dunes**

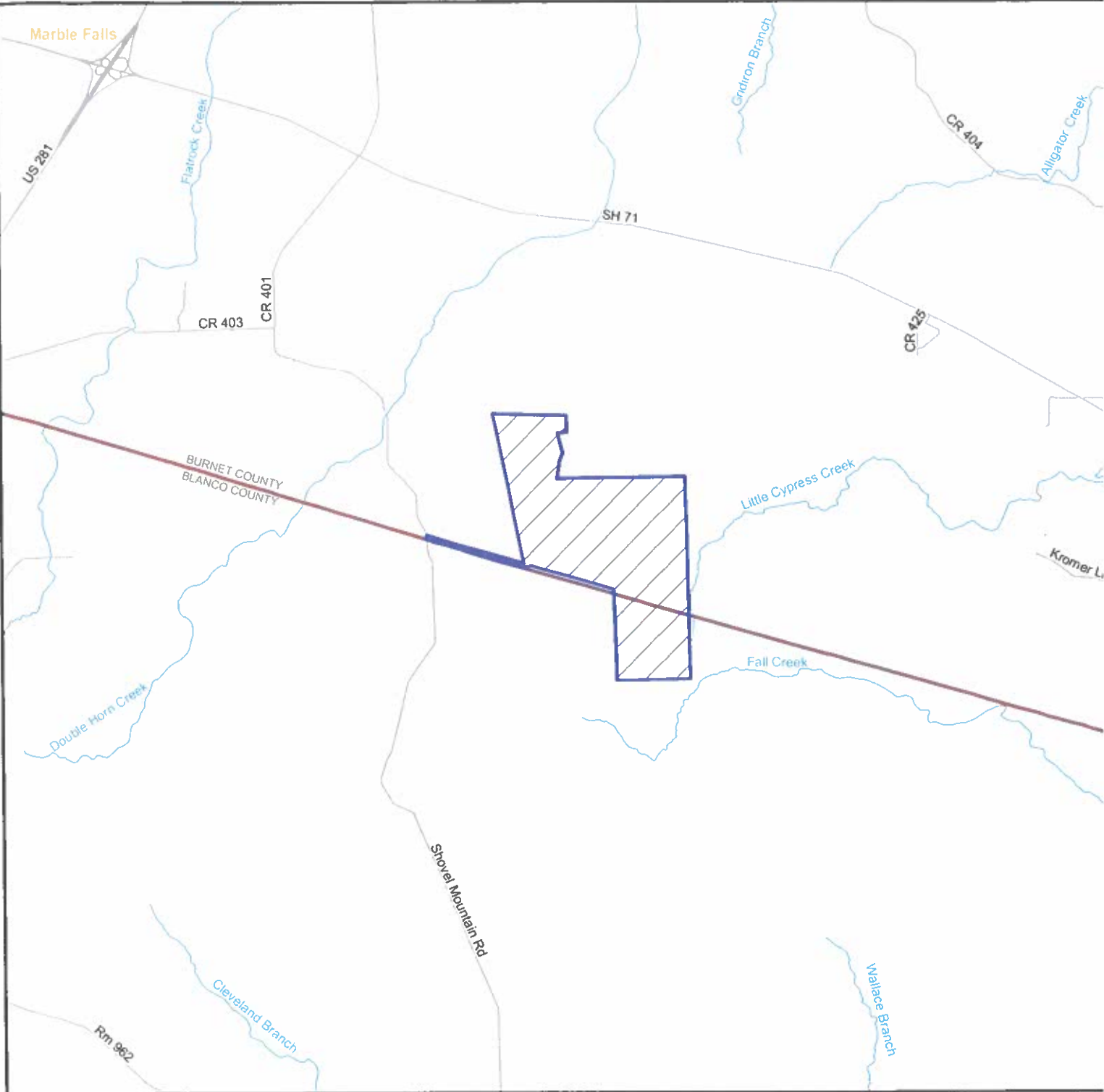

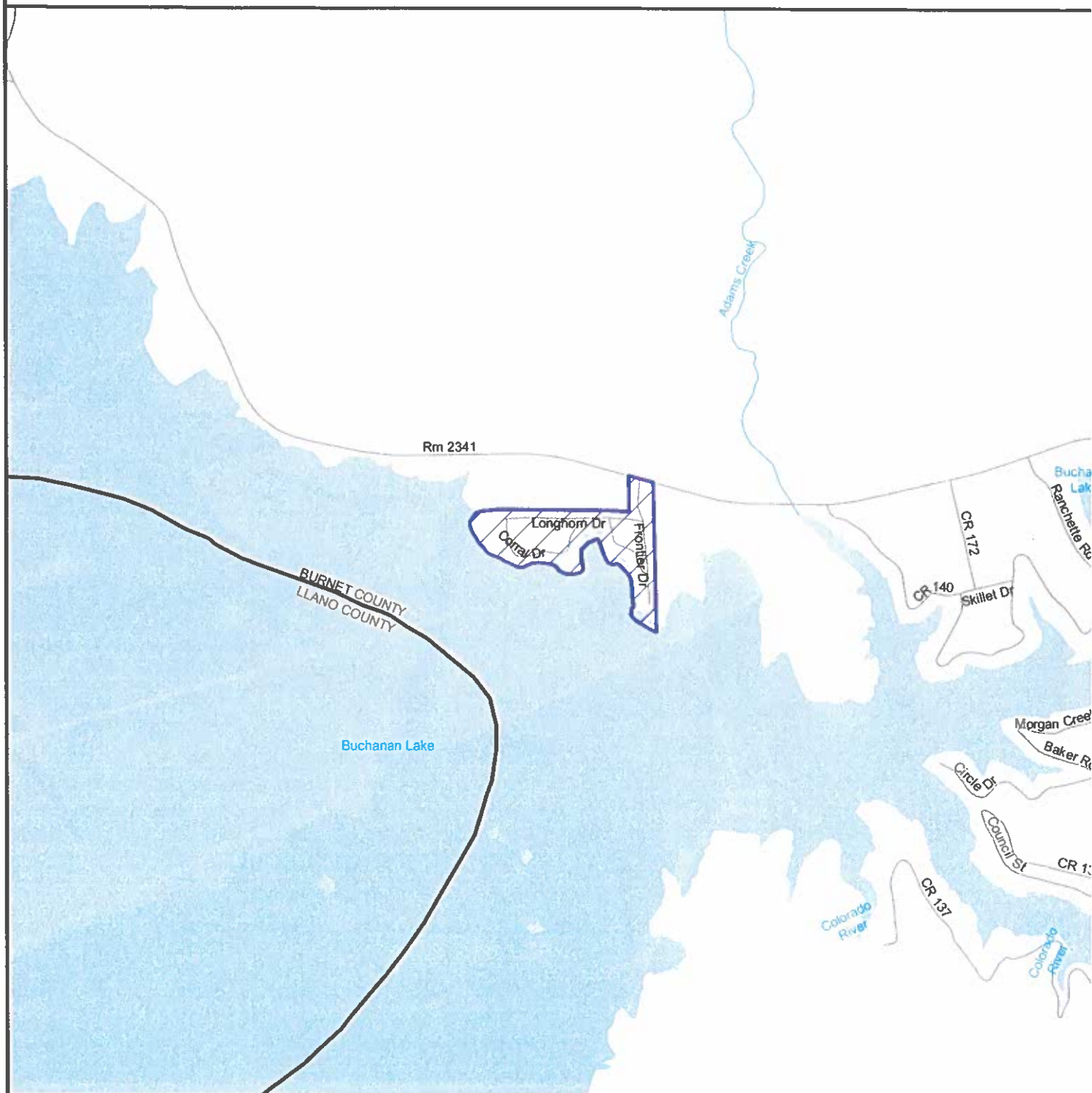
