Dear Governor,

The County of Burnet, Texas is facing significant threats to life, health, and property due to heavy rains that began on July 4.

The impact of this threat is: damage to energy infrastructure, water and sewer infrastructure, transportation infrastructure, communications infrastructure, homes, businesses, and life safety. Due to the current rainfall and flood condition and forecasts we expect this to continue through today, July 5.

I have determined that the threat is of such severity and magnitude that an effective response would be beyond the capability of the local jurisdiction to control. Pursuant to §418.108 of the Texas Government Code, I am requesting that you attach Burnet County to the a state of emergency for the State of Texas regarding the heavy rains that have impacted the state.

Furthermore, I am asking that successive proclamations be issued and remain in effect until the threat of loss of life, injury, or damage to property is contained.

DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER

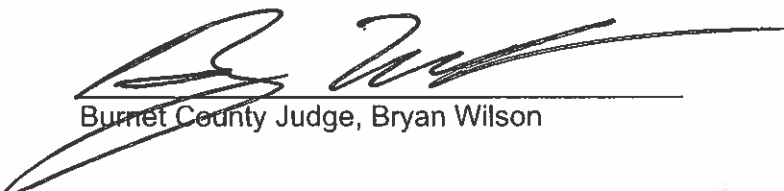
WHEREAS, the County of Burnet beginning on the 4th day of ~~January~~ ^{JULY}, 2025 has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from excessive multiple rounds of rainfall;

WHEREAS, the Judge of the County of Burnet has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property and infrastructure;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED, PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 418.108 OF THE TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE, BY THE BURNET COUNTY JUDGE:

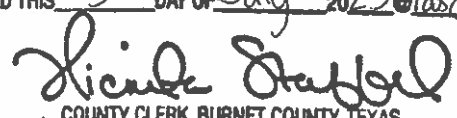
1. That a state of disaster is declared for the County of Burnet.
2. That the County's Emergency Management Plan has been implemented.
3. That this state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days of the date hereof, unless the same is continued by consent of the Commissioners Court of the County of Burnet, Texas.
4. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
