Dear Judge Wilson,

We are three ranch owners in Burnet County with large properties near Briggs in Precinct 2 who are directly affected by the proposed Bell County East to Big Hill 765-kV transmission project. We are adamantly opposed to this project for a host of reasons, including those set forth in the Texas Public Policy Foundation's letter to the Public Utility Commission dated December 19, 2025. That letter correctly points out many flaws in the proposed project albeit not nearly all of them. We respectfully request that the County support and work with the TPPF in its efforts to get this project stopped.

Also, thank you for hosting the January 16 Burnet County Workshop meeting. It was informative and helpful. In particular, we were interested in the remarks made by Mr. Dan Byfield with American Stewards of Liberty about the potential use of 391 Commissions to fight against the proposed transmission project. We again respectfully request that the County do proper due diligence on the potential helpfulness of such a commission, report back to the landowners of Burnet County, and take all steps available to expose the misguided and incorrect environmental as well as economic, power-supply/demand, and market analyses regarding this project.
