Judges & Commissioners

Lead & Manage the County

Visit them: for help during disasters, road repairs, to attend public meetings and more.



Auditors, Tax Assessor-Collectors & Treasurers

Typically Handle Money & Taxes

Visit them: to pay taxes, register your car, ask about county payments, to report misuse of funds and more.



County & District Clerks

Keep Official Records

Visit them: for vital records, court documents, election information and more.



County and District Attorneys & Justices of the Peace

Primarily Handle Legal Matters

Visit them: for legal help, to fight a ticket, information on a court case and more.



Sheriffs & Constables

Chiefly Keep the Peace

Visit them: for law enforcement, jail info, to have court papers delivered and more.
