Proposition A – \$133M

Burnet Middle New Academic Facility & Renovations

- New academic building for 900 students, expandable to 1,200
- Classrooms, science labs, and elective spaces
- Library/media center
- Cafeteria and kitchen
- Special education spaces
- Renovations to fine arts and athletics areas

RJ Richey Elementary Campus Improvements

- New classrooms using existing campus space
- Separate art and music classrooms
- Renovated gym converted to cafetorium and kitchen
- Right-size special education space

Bertram Elementary Campus

- New secure front entry to improve safety and controlled access

Districtwide Renovations & Infrastructure

- Roof, HVAC, and electrical system replacements
- Interior finish updates (flooring, ceilings, walls)
- Building protection and safety system upgrades
- LED lighting upgrades

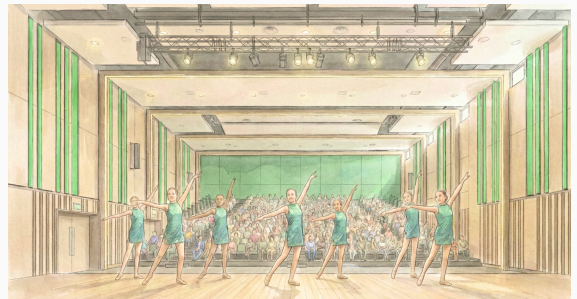
Districtwide Items

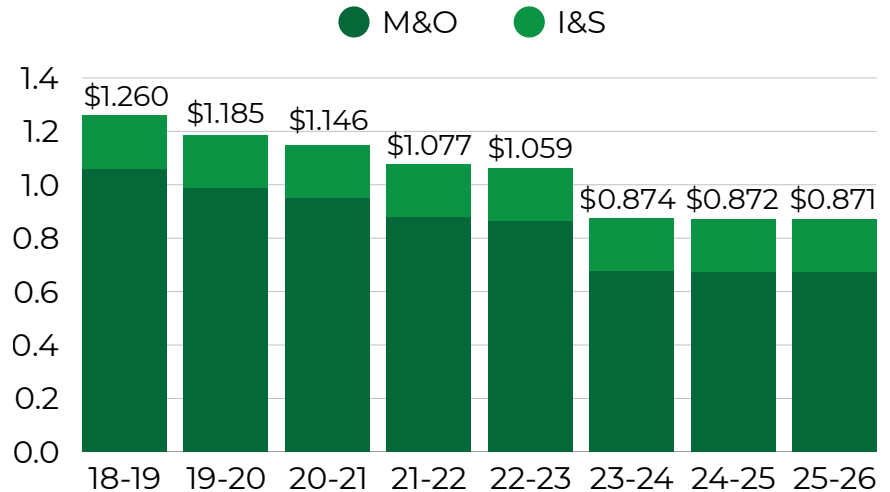

Tax Rate History & Impact

Total Tax Rate **decrease of 39 cents** over the last 10 years.

The I&S tax rate is projected to remain at its current level, \$0.871 per \$100 of taxable property value.

No I&S tax rate increase is anticipated under the recommended bond package.



For property owners 65 and older:

Homeowners 65+ with an exemption will not see an ISD tax rate increase on their homestead if the bond is approved and no major improvements are made to the homestead.
