APRIL 18, 2026 EVENT**

- **292** Vehicles attended the event representing 350 households
- Attendees by location – Burnet 123, Marble Falls 51, Bertram 38, Spicewood 14, Meadowlakes 10, Highland Haven 5, Horseshoe Bay 14, Granite Shoals 12, Kingsland 3, Cottonwood Shores 5, Lampasas 5, Smithwick 2, Double Horn 2, Liberty Hill 5, Oatmeal 2, and Joppa 1.
- 58 Volunteers from all over the County!
- Received \$1,323 in donations at the event

Collected items quantity

- Scrap tires – 882
- Lead acid batteries – 134 and over 2,688 alkaline batteries
- Used oil – 825 gallons or 15 drums
- Antifreeze – 1.5 drums
- Electronics – One 53' trailer full
- Loose Metals – 5560 pounds

Cost of the event:

- Quantities of paint, and other items collected by outside vendor were unavailable at the time of this publication.
- Total cost to Burnet County - **unknown at the time of this release**
- No grant funds were used to fund this event
