Re: Letter of Approval — Emergency Medical Services Provider Applicant: Lonestar Faith, LLC Pursuant to: Tex. Health & Safety Code §773.0573 and 25 Tex. Admin. Code §157.11

Dear Mr. Devine

This letter serves as the official Letter of Approval issued by the Burnet County Commissioners Court to Lonestar Faith, LLC, authorizing the operation of an emergency medical services (EMS) provider and the provision of ambulance services within Burnet County, Texas, subject to the terms, conditions, and limitations set forth herein.

We have reviewed the application submitted by Lonestar Faith, LLC, and have determined that the proposed EMS services will not interfere with or adversely affect the provision of emergency medical services by the licensed emergency medical services providers operating in the County; the addition of another licensed emergency medical services provider will remedy an existing provider shortage that cannot be resolved through the use of the licensed emergency medical services providers operating in the County; and the addition of another licensed emergency medical services provider will not cause an oversupply of licensed emergency medical services providers in the County. Therefore, the Burnet County Commissioners Court hereby approves Lonestar Faith, LLC to operate as an emergency medical services provider and to provide ambulance services within Burnet County, Texas.

Burnet County does not object to Lonestar Faith, LLC being issued an EMS provider license by the Texas Department of State Health Services in accordance with applicable state law and regulations.

IV. CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

This Letter of Approval is granted subject to the following conditions:

1. **State Licensure Required.** This Letter of Approval does not constitute a license to operate and does not authorize Lonestar Faith, LLC to provide EMS services until all required state licenses and certifications have been obtained from the applicable state agency in accordance with Texas Health and Safety Code Chapter 773 and 25 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 157.
2. **Compliance with Applicable Law.** Lonestar Faith, LLC shall at all times comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, rules, and regulations governing the provision of emergency medical services, including but not limited to Texas Health and Safety

Code Chapter 773, 25 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 157, and all standards established by the Texas Department of State Health Services and the Texas Division of Emergency Management.

3. **Personnel Requirements.** All EMS personnel employed or contracted by Lonestar Faith, LLC shall maintain current certification at the appropriate level as required by state law and shall comply with all applicable continuing education and recertification requirements.
4. **Vehicle and Equipment Standards.** All ambulances and EMS vehicles operated by Lonestar Faith, LLC within Burnet County shall meet all applicable state standards for vehicle design, equipment, and maintenance as set forth in 25 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 157.
5. **Insurance Requirements.** Lonestar Faith, LLC shall maintain adequate liability insurance coverage at all times during the operation of EMS services within Burnet County in amounts sufficient to cover claims arising from EMS operations. Evidence of current insurance coverage shall be provided to the County upon request.
6. **Cooperation with County and Local Authorities.** Lonestar Faith, LLC shall cooperate with Burnet County, local fire departments, law enforcement agencies, hospitals, and other EMS providers operating within the County to ensure coordinated and effective emergency response services.
7. **Notification of Material Changes.** Lonestar Faith, LLC shall provide written notice to the Burnet County Commissioners Court within thirty (30) days of any material change in its operations, ownership, service area, service level, or state licensure status.
8. **Compliance with Local EMS System.** Lonestar Faith, LLC shall operate in a manner consistent with the Burnet County EMS system, including compliance with any applicable local protocols, mutual aid agreements, and medical director requirements.
9. **Right to Revoke.** The Burnet County Commissioners Court reserves the right to revoke or modify this Letter of Approval upon a finding that Lonestar Faith, LLC has failed to comply with the conditions set forth herein, has failed to maintain required state licensure, or has otherwise operated in a manner inconsistent with the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Burnet County. Prior to revocation, the County shall provide written notice and a reasonable opportunity to cure any identified deficiency, except in cases where an immediate threat to public safety exists.

This Letter of Approval was authorized by action of the Burnet County Commissioners Court at a duly noticed public meeting held on May 12, 2026, in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Tex. Gov't Code Chapter 551.
