

Speaker Agreement

Ms. Ghada Wahdan agrees to conduct a four (4)-hour presentation on U.S. National Security to Burnet County Sheriffs' Office in Texas, consisting primarily of law enforcement professionals, on 18 September 2026. The presentation will be delivered twice for a morning and an afternoon session for a total of eight (8) hours on the same day.

Compensation

Burnet County Sheriffs' Office agrees to pay Ms. Wahdan **\$6,500.00** for the eight (8) hours specialized training. The fee will be paid to Ms. Wahdan upon the completion of the presentation on 18 September 2026. All travel expenses (airfare, luggage, hotel, parking, transportation and per diem) are included in proposed fee.

Cancellation

If Burnet County Sheriff's Office cancels the event ten (10) days or fewer prior to the scheduled date, the Sheriff's Office shall be fully responsible for reimbursing the Speaker for any non-refundable travel fees and related expenses already incurred, including but not limited to airfare, lodging deposits, ground transportation, and other pre-approved travel costs. Speaker will provide receipts or documentation of these expenses upon request.

Independent Contractor

Ms. Wahdan is an independent contractor and not an employee, agent, or representative of Burnet County Sheriffs' Office. Neither Party has the authority to bind the other.

Intellectual Property

Ms. Wahdan retains ownership of all intellectual property rights in the presentation materials, including slides, handouts, and content delivered during the presentation. Information presented is derived from open source material and is subject to change based on foreign policies and current international developments. This presentation may contain graphic images. Burnet County Sheriffs' Office is granted a limited, non-exclusive license to use the materials solely for internal purposes, provided Ms. Wahdan is credited. Recording or distributing the presentation requires Ms. Wahdan's prior written consent. Ms. Wahdan's biography and information are sensitive and may be shared with state, tribal, or local government law enforcement officials or partner agencies with a need-to-know for training purposes only.

Technology and Equipment

Burnet County Sheriffs' Office will provide a screen, lavalier microphone, audio, and WIFI. Burnet County Sheriffs' Office is responsible to pre-test all equipment prior to the presentation to avoid technical difficulties at the time of the presentation. Ms. Wahdan will provide a laptop to display the presentation.

Ms. Wahdan agrees not to disclose confidential information shared by Burnet County Sheriffs' Office such as operational details or member data without prior written consent, except as required by law.

Force Majeure

Neither Ms. Wahdan nor Burnet County Sheriffs' Office shall be liable for failure to perform due to events beyond their reasonable control such as natural disasters or government restrictions. Ms. Wahdan and Burnet County Sheriffs' Office will work in good faith to reschedule the presentation if feasible.

Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Oklahoma. Any disputes shall be resolved through mediation in Tulsa, OK, or, if unresolved, in a court of competent jurisdiction in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between Ms. Wahdan and Burnet County Sheriffs' Office and supersedes all prior agreements. Amendments must be in writing and signed by both Parties.

Presenter's Biography

Ghada Wahdan is a national security analyst and presenter who delivers dynamic, intelligence-informed briefings on emerging threats facing the United States. With experience studying foreign influence, extremism, and geopolitical conflict, she provides audiences with a clear understanding of how global events intersect with domestic vulnerabilities, security policies, and public perception.



Ghada's presentations cover a range of high-priority national security issues including China's long-term strategic posture toward the United States, the evolving power vacuum in Afghanistan, and risks associated with SIV and refugee vetting processes following large-scale resettlement efforts. Her work also examines instability related to Syria, the Hamas-Israel conflict, and how Middle Eastern dynamics shape regional alliances, proxy activity, and threat vectors affecting American interests abroad and within U.S. borders.

Domestically, Ghada highlights concerns tied to foreign governments influencing civil discourse, funding protest movements, and exploiting social media ecosystems to amplify divisive narratives. Her lectures explore the rise of political violence, the weaponization of information, and the shifting national dialogue surrounding immigration and national identity. Known for her ability to translate complex global issues into clear, digestible analysis, she equips law enforcement, policymakers, academia, and community stakeholders with insight to strengthen awareness, preparedness, and resilience.

Ghada holds a Master of Arts in Criminology from Regis University, a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice & Criminology from Metropolitan State University of Denver and is fluent in Arabic in eleven different dialects. Her work encourages critical thinking, balanced discussion, and informed decision-making in an increasingly volatile and interconnected world.
