WHEREAS, September 17, 2026, marks the two hundred and thirty-ninth anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary, as well as to the patriotic celebrations which commemorate the occasion; and

WHEREAS, Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17 through September 23 as Constitution Week; and

WHEREAS, the Constitution of the United States remains a guardian of our liberties and the foundation of our system of government, protecting the freedoms and rights enjoyed by the citizens of our nation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED that the Burnet County Commissioners Court hereby recognizes and proclaims the week of **September 17 through September 23, 2026, as**

CONSTITUTION WEEK

AND, we ask the citizens of Burnet County to reaffirm the ideals of the Framers of the Constitution in 1787 by vigilantly protecting the freedoms guaranteed to us through this guardian of our liberties, remembering that lost rights may never be regained.
